Election of Godparents: One Godparent is required. Two Godparents—one male, one female may be appointed. Godparents must be practicing Catholics, 16 years of age or older, fully initiated into the Church (Baptized and Confirmed) at least 6 months before baptism. A non-Catholic may stand as a Christian Witness. Former Catholics are ineligible. Godparents must obtain a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor; Christian Witnesses must provide a copy of their baptismal record. These documents and baptismal stipend must be received by the parish office one week before the day of Baptism.

EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL

This year's celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, On June 19, 2022, a three-year National Eucharistic Revival called for by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) began. The goal of the Eucharistic Revival is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. To this end, we pray for the success of this revival, asking all of you to pray the following two prayers daily, which the three visionaries received at Fatima from the angel:

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee. (Pray three times)

Most Holy Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit- I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifferences whereby He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners. Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us.

Deacon Claude's Message

The month of July brings fond memories for me growing up as a kid in Bridgeport. Of course, enough contentment was our being in the middle of summer vacation. Moreover though, as members of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish, we all looked forward with great excitement to the annual Grande Festa Italiana of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, held typically on the second weekend of July.

All along the procession route, houses displayed the Papal flag along with the flags of the United States and Italy. Banners hung high above the street reminding everyone of the Feast and its good times and good food. I remember the procession on Ford and Bush Streets, with various volunteers carrying the statue of Our Lady, followed by bishops, priests, dignitaries, and devoted laity after a Sunday High Mass; the Italian feast with various entertainment, amusements, rides and games, fireworks on Sunday evening to cap the festivities, various delicious Italian foods, and the many volunteers that made it all possible.

Sadly, this special feast celebration is no more. Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish has been merged, along with St. Augustine and Mother of Sorrows Parishes into Sacred Heart in Swedesburg. However, devotion to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel remains throughout the world. Her feast day is July 16.

Sacred Scripture celebrated the beauty of Carmel where the prophet Elijah defended the purity of Israel's faith in the living God (1 Kings 18: 19-40). In the twelfth century, hermits withdrew to that mountain overlooking the Plain of Megiddo and later founded the Order devoted to the contemplative life under the patronage of Mary, the Mother of God. **(IBreviary)**

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is a title of the Blessed Virgin Mary associated with the Carmelite Order. The first Carmelites lived as hermits on Mt. Carmel in the Holy Land beginning in the 12th century. In the middle of their hermitages they built a chapel dedicated to the Virgin Mary, who became the protectress of the Carmelites under the title of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to a Carmelite hermit, St. Simon Stock, under this title and gave him a piece of cloth—the brown scapular—as a sacramental to be worn by the faithful to whom she promised her special protection.

Mary also asked that those who consecrate themselves to her wear it as a sign of that consecration. For more on the Brown Scapular, see the Sisters of Carmel (<https://www.sistersofcarmel.com/brown-scapular-information.php>).

Lucia, the visionary of Our Lady of Fatima, reported that in her last apparition (October 1917), Mary appeared with the Carmelite habit, the scapular in her hand, and said that her true children wear it with reverence. **(Morning Offering <https://www.morningoffering.com/offering/2022-07-16/>)**

Pope Pius X decreed in the early 20th century that this blessing of the Blessed Virgin would also extend to all who wear the medal of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

“Devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a special call to the interior life, which is preeminently a Marian life. Our Lady wants us to resemble her not only in our outward appearance but, far more, in heart and spirit. If we gaze into Mary's soul, we shall see that grace in her has flowered into a spiritual life of incalculable wealth: a life of recollection, prayer, uninterrupted oblation to God, continual contact, and intimate union with him. Mary's

soul is a sanctuary reserved for God alone, where no human creature has ever left its trace, where love and zeal for the glory of God and the salvation of humankind reign supreme. [...]

Those who want to live their devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel to the full must follow Mary into the depths of her interior life. Carmel is the symbol of the contemplative life, the life wholly dedicated to the quest for God, wholly orientated towards intimacy with God; and the one who has best realized this highest of ideals is Our Lady herself, ‘Queen and Beauty of Carmel.’ **(Taken From—Divine Intimacy, Fr. 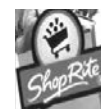

ST. TITUS OUTREACH PROGRAM

St. Titus Parish has been making casseroles for St. John's Hospice in Center City Philadelphia for over 25 years. ***On an average day, SJH serves 57 casseroles to hundreds of residents and day service guests. Casseroles are donated by 47 parishes in the area including our parish.***

The casseroles are the "Main Course" of a complete, hot meal that is served to hundreds of God's poor and homeless who come to St. John's for their daily bread. Please do not feel restricted to the recipes which can be found on the recipe sheets near the casserole pan in the vestibule. Your favorite recipe is most welcome! So are store bought casseroles such as Stouffers or Oncor. St. John's provides us with pans and lids for your dishes. If you provide your own, please use a standard "half tray". Each casserole serves 6-8 men. Each month, St. John's picks up the dishes from our freezer.



Here are some useful hints:

- Please bring your casseroles frozen to church and put them in the freezer located in the vestibule of the Social Hall. If the door to the Social Hall is locked, please leave the casserole with a sacristan or maintenance.
- Prepare your recipe so that it can be eaten with a plastic "spork" (a combination spoon and fork).
- Please mark the lid with the main ingredients and date you prepared your casserole.

3. Mail your envelopes in or drop them off at the Parish Office, Monday-Friday, 9am-4pm.

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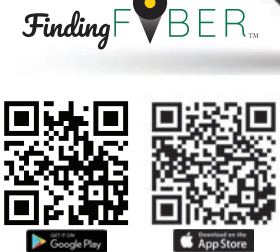


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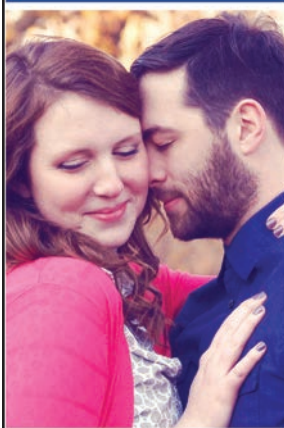
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
