

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Schedule with Parish Office for any Sunday at 11:15am. Pre-Baptismal classes are required for parents and optional for Godparents. Classes are usually offered the first Monday of the month at 7pm at St. Helena Parish. Call the St. Helena Parish Office (610-275-7711) to register for class. Letters of eligibility are due at the St. Titus Parish Office before a date for Baptism can be confirmed.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Couples must make arrangements at least six months in advance of the requested date. Contact the Parish Office to schedule an appointment with clergy. All couples are required to attend Pre-Marital class before marriage. Go to Archphila.org under Marriage preparations to register for the class online.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

Catholics who are seriously ill or weakened by old age are encouraged to request this Sacrament. Those entering the hospital for surgery are invited to receive this sacrament prior to admission. **To arrange home visits for anointing, confession or Holy Communion for parishioners, please call the Parish Office at 610-279-4990.**



Election of Godparents: One Godparent is required. Two Godparents—one male, one female may be appointed. Godparents must be practicing Catholics, 16 years of age or older, fully initiated into the Church (Baptized and Confirmed) at least 6 months before baptism. A non-Catholic may stand as a Christian Witness. Former Catholics are ineligible. Godparents must obtain a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their parish; Christian Witnesses must provide a copy of their baptismal record. These documents and baptismal stipend must be received by the parish office one week before the day of Baptism.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION: All children attending a Catholic public or private school (Grades 2 or Grades 7 &8) are to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation at the parish where registered. If you are members of St. Titus Parish, please contact the Parish Office 610-279-4990 for Sacrament info and registration.

Deacon Claude's Corner—Giving Thanks

"Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change." (James 1: 17)

We are reminded at each Mass, "***It is truly right and just, our duty and salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God, through Christ our Lord.***"

These words of prayer especially ring true for this time of thanking God. Just by the fact that we have life, free will, and intellect, we should constantly thank God. The words of Psalm 8 (vs 5-6) come to mind:

"What is man that you are mindful of him, and a son of man that you care for him? Yet you have made him little less than a god, crowned him with glory and honor." And so right off the bat, as we rise to a new day each morning, we should thank God for life.

With its symbols and family meals, Thanksgiving reminds us of the bounty of the harvest; the food and drink from nature that God gives us. And so we also contemplate God's creation in all its beauty and the sustenance God provides.

Do we take time from our busy, hectic, frenetic world to truly observe creation and thank God who made all this endless beauty just for us? Life itself, in all forms; the earth, moon, sun, galaxies and stars; the beauty and power of the weather and seas and oceans; assorted colors of nature; rainbows; trees, growth, harvest, and vegetation; and, the life and intellect of humankind!

As Christians we consider that God's supernatural gifts of faith, hope and love lead us beyond our physical, mortal existence to the eternal by living in Christ. From the Bible, we read: "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly" (John 10:10).

While we have done nothing to merit it, God gives us eternal life in and through Christ. When we were baptized, we were incorporated into the Holy Trinity, the communion of God's Divine Life of Love. While we will hopefully experience the fullness of this life eternally in Heaven, eternal life should begin for each of us here on earth with our Baptism and nourished through the Word of God and the Sacraments, especially Holy Eucharist, the Bread of Life. Through His Word and the Sacraments, Jesus plugs our lives into eternity.

And so we thank God especially for eternal life that God wishes to share with us, and the supernatural graces He gives us on our journey to lead us into Heaven, eternal communion with the Holy Trinity.

For reflection:

- Do I thank God for the gift of my life? The lives of my parents, ancestors, spouse, family, those whose lives have touched me and whose lives I have touched?
- Do I thank God for the beauty of creation that surrounds me?
- How much thought and reflection do I give to the gifts of God's Word and the Sacraments? Do I appreciate these gifts from God? Do I open these gifts and use them as Christ intended for my salvation, growth, and holiness?
- Do I thank and praise the Lord for the gift of eternal life in Christ?

"When you sit down to eat, pray. When you eat bread, do so thanking Him for being so generous to you. If you drink wine, be mindful of Him who has given it to you for your pleasure and as a relief in sickness.

When you dress, thank Him for His kindness in providing you with clothes. When you look at the sky and the beauty of the stars, throw yourself at God's feet and adore Him who in His wisdom has arranged things in this way. Similarly, when the sun goes down and when it rises, when you are asleep or awake, give thanks to God, who created and arranged all things for your benefit, to have you know, love and praise their Creator." (***St. Basil the Great***)
