My Dear Parishioners,

Thank you so much for your concerns for my health and also for your prayers. I am extremely grateful.

The Interfaith Service for the five policemen whose lives were taken in such a violent way was a memorable and moving occasion. The presence of the President, Mr. Obama, Vice President Biden and former President Bush and their wives were a witness to the magnitude of the challenges facing our country.

As a community of faith, our response must always be based on our shared Gospel values. Last Sunday's Gospel reminded us, in the person of the Good Samaritan, of this very point.

Please keep the evening of Monday, August 15, free. On that evening I propose a symposium of various interested parties representative of our community. Deacon Larry and I will also be part of that panel. We are being helped by a representative from The Anti-Defamation League, with whom we have good working relationship.

We will be invoking the prayers of Mary, Queen of Peace, as it is the Feast of the Assumption, although not a holy day of obligation. I pray that we gather in faith and hope, to listen, perhaps at times to those whose experience is different from ours, and to use the hearts and minds that God has given us to find solutions to what are the real challenges for us as faithful citizens.

Please keep the most recent victims in Nice, France in your prayers, and continue to pray for all who are affected by hate crimes and acts of terrorism.

St. Theresa in Memorial Park is seeking a Coordinator of Elementary Faith Formation and Children's Sacrament Preparation. Responsibilities include coordination and administration of Faith Formation and Sacramental Preparation sessions, including special activities such as music, paraliturgies, prayer services, parent meetings, lesson plans, Vacation Bible School, Children's Liturgy of the Word, and Sacred and Safe lessons. Coordinator will use innovative teaching ideas, such as multi-media resources and other non-traditional teaching tools. Coordinator will recruit and train volunteer catechists and supervise on-site session coordinators.
