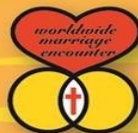

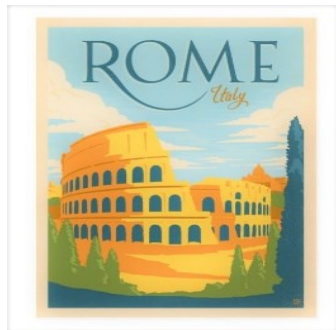

## **Rice University Walking Tour & Picnic Lunch Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup> (10:30am)**

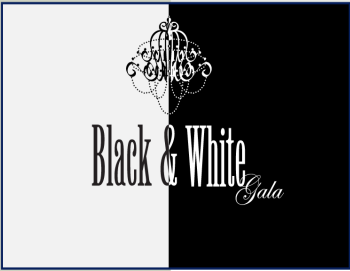

## **Private Tour - "Gladiators: Heroes of the Colosseum" Wednesday June 21<sup>st</sup> (4pm)**

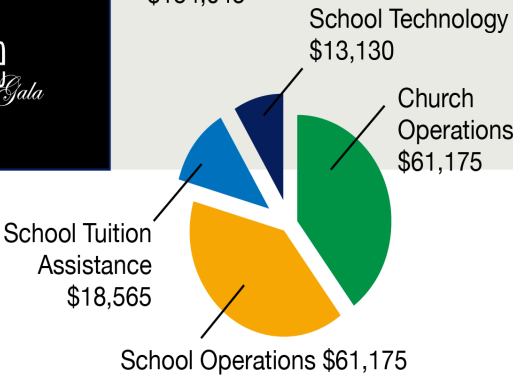

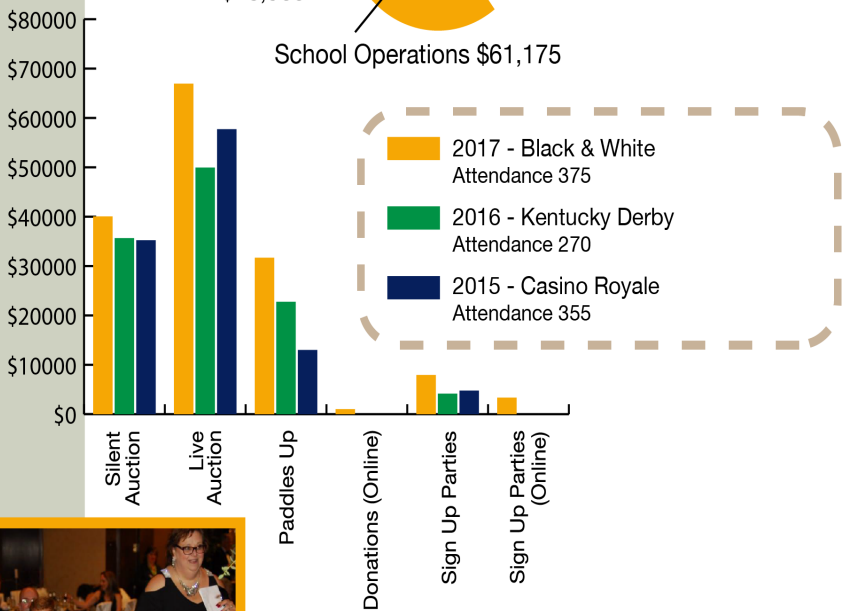

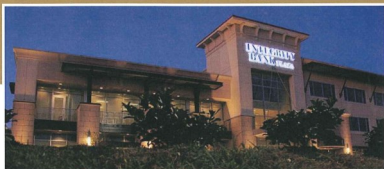
