How Will the School Be Impacted by Church and School Construction?

We are so excited about the new building that will provide new classrooms, offices, faculty work areas, and lab space for St. Theresa School. While the new building is under construction, there will be some changes and perhaps modest disturbances to the school life. The following are some quick notes as to how we will be impacted. *For a more complete picture, see the Capital Campaign/Construction FAQs at <http://www.sttheresa.cc/faqs>.*

The changes we will experience will include:

- ◆ The 5th grade and Jr. High Religion classes will move to the new portable
- ◆ The parking lot behind the gym will be a bit smaller due to the new portable
- ◆ All athletic games will have to be played away during the construction period
- ◆ School Masses will move to Monday
- ◆ After September 17, School Masses will be in the gym
- ◆ The carpool loading zone will move down the driveway alongside the gym
- ◆ Foot traffic patterns through and around the campus will be rerouted
- ◆ There will be a need for more careful planning of space use for meetings, programs and ministries

*Most importantly, our focus during the construction period will be on the safety of the school children and their parents. Additionally, the school administration will work to see that the students are minimally disturbed or distracted by the noise and disruption associated with the school and church construction projects. **We look forward to a year of excitement as the students, teachers, and parents look forward to the first new School Building at St. Theresa in 50 years!***

Praying with the Masters Today

In this seminar, there will be a brief introduction to the nature of mysticism through an exploration of the development of contemplative prayer in the Christian tradition.

I will sketch the understanding of contemplation in some of the premier mystics in the history of Christianity. These great mystics are not just historical monuments, but active resources for those drawn to the contemplative life.

Contemplative prayer is a conversation with God (as Teresa says), but for us today, I will argue, it is also a dialogue with the contemplative tradition, as modern mystical teachers have shown. I intend my comments not so much as purely academic presentations, but as reflections to stimulate the meaning of contemplative prayer today

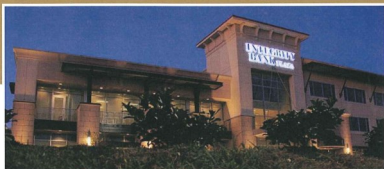
