Capital Campaign Update



What about Baptisms, Marriages, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation when we move to the gym?

This weekend marks five weeks until our final weekend of celebrating Mass in the Church. As we move, life will continue to go on for parishioners. Already, arrangements have been planned to continue celebrating the Sacrament of Baptism within the context of the Sunday Mass. In a way, this will help us to look forward to the day when we can use our new permanent baptismal font at the entry to the Church! On the other hand, group Baptisms, which tend to be more intimate celebrations with congregations of 50–60 people or at most 100 people, will be celebrated not in the gym but in the Fellowship Hall, which will allow these more intimate groups to share in the sacrament in a special way – close to the sacramental action.

As for Marriages, we have been encouraging those who are preparing for Marriage to reach out to one of our neighboring Catholic churches such as All Saints, St. Anne's, or even Annunciation downtown. We are happy to do the work of preparing couples for marriage and even to witness Marriages that are celebrated at another Church while our Church building is being renovated. We look forward to the day, in 15 months or so, when we can begin hosting the Rite of Marriage at St. Theresa again.

The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be celebrated in the Fellowship Hall on Wednesday evenings before Mass and in the Gym on Saturdays before the 5:30 pm Mass. The specific locations will be marked at the time of the move, but you can count on the usual times for the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

What about parking once we move out of the Church?


There is good news for everyone! Once the construction fences are in place and we move out of the Church, we will be parking in some new places, but overall are only losing four spaces. We successfully just about balanced what spaces will be lost with new parking opportunities, which will be detailed out later. Parking is not expected to be a big problem during construction, which is really good news! So, spread the word, we will have plenty of seating and adequate parking to handle our Sunday Mass crowds!



Pilgrimage Announcement


