My Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Theresa,

It is good to prepare, to wait. It is not easy, but it is important and it teaches us patience and an ability to delay gratification. It creates an opportunity to rest and reflect on that which is important.

As our parish and school renewal continues we make space for an interior change. I hope the following words of one the churches' finest teachers and writers from the last century will help all of us on our journey to new birth.

"Advent is the "sacrament" of the PRESENCE of God in His world, in the Mystery of Christ at work in History....

This mystery is the revelation of God Himself in His Incarnate Son. But it is not merely a manifestation of the Divine Perfections, it is the concrete plan of God for the salvation of men and the restoration of the whole word in Christ.

This plan is envisaged not as a future prospect but as a present *fact*. The "last things" are already present and realized in a hidden manner. The Kingdom of God is thus already "in the midst of us." But, the mystery can only be known by those who enter into it, who find their place in the Mystical Christ, and therefore find the mystery of Christ realized and fulfilled in *themselves*."

Lord Jesus, assuage our blindness and activate our hearts during this Advent, so that we may find your presence hidden in ourselves. May we unveil the mystery of Christ-with-us and work toward the true restoration of the whole world in your image. Let your light shine in our hearts so that we may always know the truth of your love.
