My Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Theresa,

Tomorrow we remember Martin Luther King, Jr. Please pray for all those that suffer discrimination of any kind. In a spirit of prayer and solidarity, may we remember his timeless words: "Let us not seek to satisfy our thirst for freedom by drinking of the cup of bitterness and hatred. We must ever conduct our struggle with the high plains of dignity and discipline. We must not allow our creative protest to degenerate into physical violence. Again and again we must rise to the majestic heights of meeting physical force with love."

Thursday also marks this year's Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The theme is: "Your Right Hand, O Lord, Glorious in Power," Exodus 15:6.

As we start a new year, the Church asks us to focus on one of the sad realities of Christians, Division. The night before Jesus died he prayed that "That they might all be one." John 17:22. Thursday, 18th of January marks the beginning of Prayer for Christian Unity. It concludes with The Conversion of Saint Paul on January 25th.

Please take time each day during the octave of prayer to pray for unity and an end to discrimination.

Heavenly Father how it must grieve Your Holy Spirit that we have caused such barriers and divisions to be established within the body of Christ and yet it was His prayer that we are one in unity of spirit – one in the bond of peace – one in fellowship and love toward all those that are called by Your name. Help me Lord to love others as You have loved me – to love without prejudice or bias. Help me to be ready and willing to love the unlovable and to consent to be loved by others that I would likely dismiss.

Bind your people together in love and in the unity of spirit and the bond of peace and guide we pray, into all truth - knowing that ALL who trust in Your sacrifice at Calvary are forgiven sinners, citizens of heaven and accepted by the Father, in the Beloved, in whose name we pray, Amen.

FRANCIS, GO AND REPAIR MY HOUSE



You probably noticed some construction machinery at the Church and School sites. We are exited to see that soil preparation on the New School building has started and the Church interior demolition. As we continue the construction process for our buildings, we also are preparing for the spiritual renovations, opening our hearts to the Lord's call. The following passage from Bonaventure's *Life of Francis* remind us of St. Francis of Assisi's understanding of the mission

given him by the Lord:

"One day when Francis went out to meditate in the fields he was passing by the church of San Damiano which was threatening to collapse because of extreme age. Inspired by the Spirit, he went inside to pray.

Kneeling before an image of the Crucified, he was filled with great fervor and consolation as he prayed. While his tear-filled eyes were gazing at the Lord's cross, he heard with his bodily ears a voice coming from the cross, telling him three times: 'Francis, go and repair my house which, as you see, is falling into ruin.'

Trembling with fear, Francis was amazed at the sound of this astonishing voice, since he was alone in the church; and as he received in his heart the power of the divine words, he fell into a state of ecstasy. Returning finally to his senses, he prepared to put his whole heart into obeying the command he had received. He began zealously to repair the church materially, although the principle intention of the words referred to that Church which Christ purchased with his own blood, as the Holy Spirit afterward made him realize...."
