


From Father Phil

My Dear Parishioners,

here is only one more Sunday before the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year, which is the Feast of Christ the King, November 24th. The readings for today's Mass, in the spirit of endings, remind us of the "last days," a term referring to God's final triumph of love conquering death. In the last line from today's Gospel, St. Luke presents Jesus asking us to persevere so as to secure our lives. Our worship in the liturgy is matched beautifully to the changing of the weather and the reduction of light. I enjoy the morning's early light with the recent end of Daylight Savings Time, but not so much the earlier arrival of evening and night time. Perhaps the church is reminding us, not only that this life changes but that this life ends—another year is almost gone!

November is referred to as the month of the holy souls, those that have gone before us in death. Remember how we started the month celebrating those canonized by Mother Church, those formally recognized as Saints, and the next day, all those who have ever lived and died. Listen carefully to the prayers at the altar: we hear clearly that the mystery of Christ's life and death is our own.

Our very faith is built upon the one life and death of Jesus. For ages, we have prayed for Jesus to grant his Resurrection to our loved ones who have died. References to praying for the dead are found in the Second Book of Maccabees. St. Paul, in his letter to Timothy, asks for prayer for someone who has died named Onesiphorus. St. Monica, the long-suffering mother of St. Augustine of Hippo, who died toward the end of the 4th century, said: "One thing I ask of you, that you remember me at the altar of God." Please rekindle with me this great Christian practice of praying for the dead regularly in the words of an ancient prayer:




