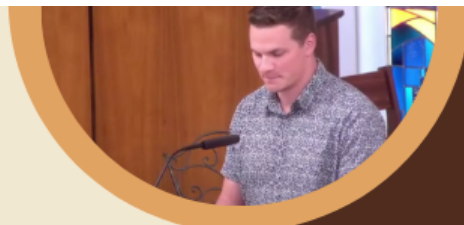


SERVICE OPPORTUNITY FOR FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH AND FAMILY
