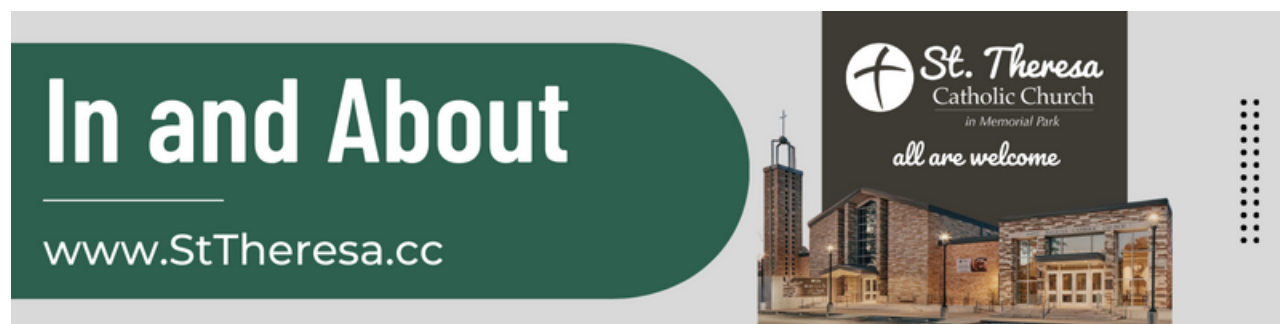

HOW TO GET CONFIRMED AS A CATHOLIC ADULT?

Catholic adults who are active in the practice of their faith but who, for whatever reason, have never received the Sacrament of Confirmation are encouraged to do so. The Adult Confirmation process will consist of welcoming potential candidates and conducting a discernment interview with them to assess readiness to enter sacramental preparation. Sacramental Preparation will begin after Easter. This preparation will consist of weekly sessions, a day of reflection, and a final interview.

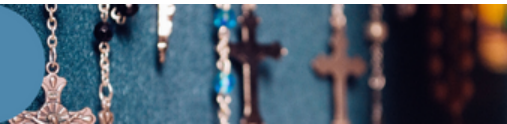
