Does modern science contradict the story of Genesis? What does the theory of evolution tell us about the creation of the world in six days?

Over the years, our beloved bell tower, which has been the cornerstone of our church since 1959, has suffered continuous damage from the elements that have affected its integrity. This only came to light at the end of the remodeling of the Church during our current capital campaign. Unfortunately, the tower has suffered significant harm and is in dire need of repair.

We have already begun assessing the cost and developing a plan to restore the tower to its former glory; our preliminary estimate indicates \$500,000 in repairs. In a few weeks, we will have a more solid amount, to which we will add a contingency number for those unknown items that have to be repaired.
