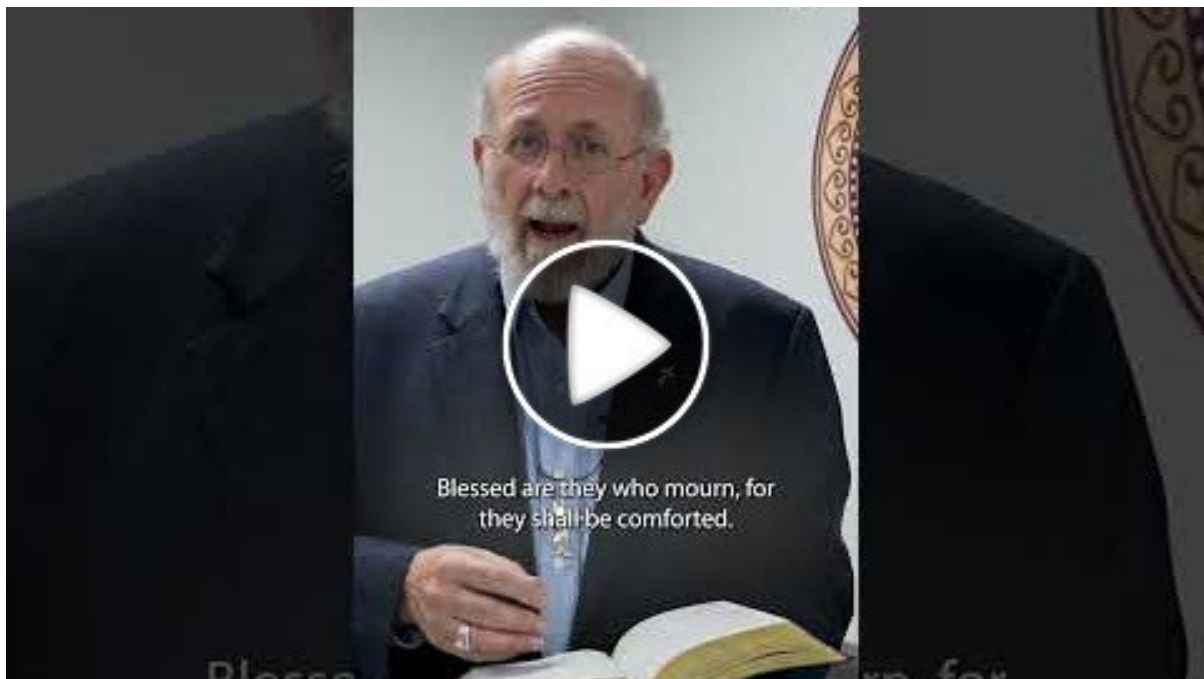

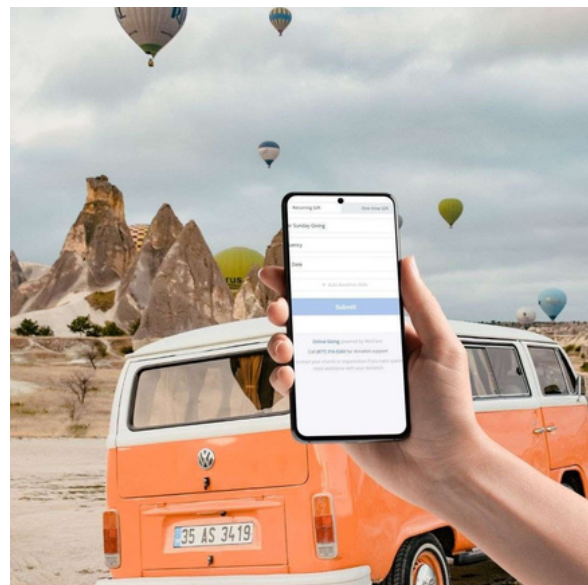
Little Flowers Sunday Nursery Closed

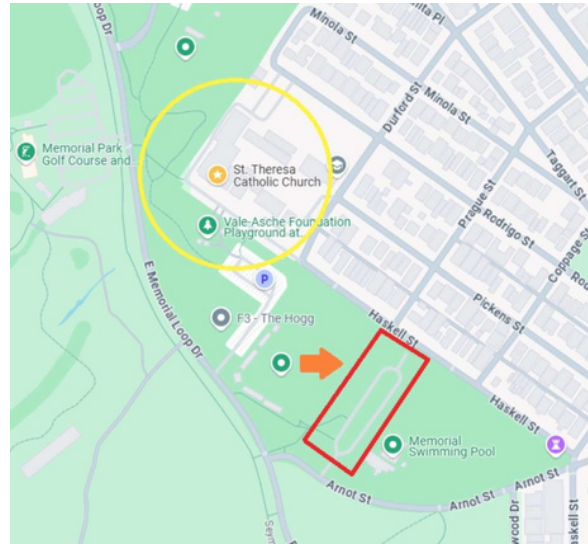
10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass Additional Overflow Parking

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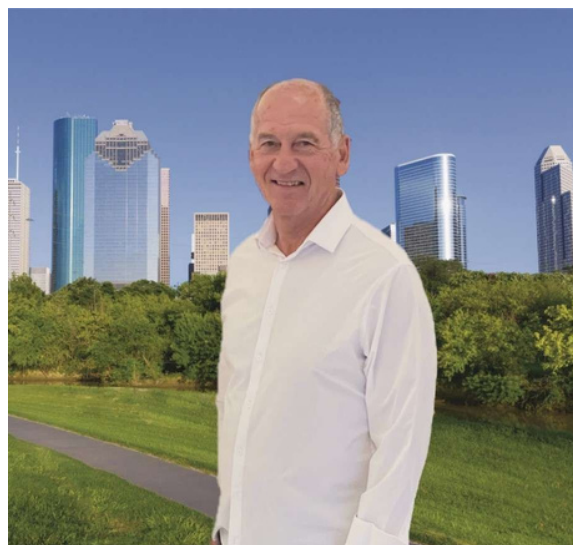
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
