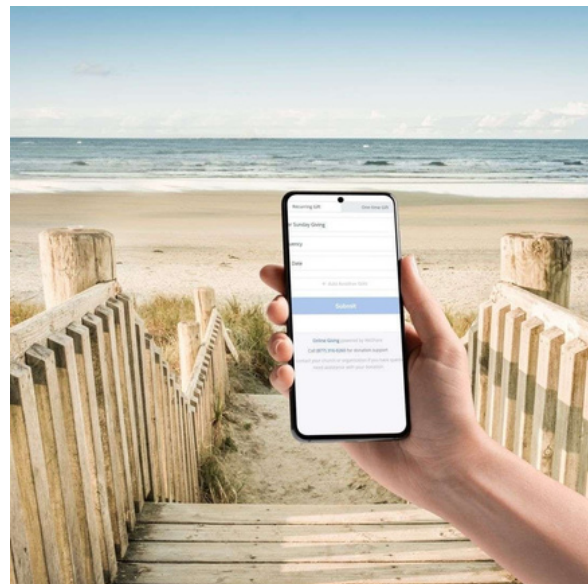
The Evangelical Power of the Nicene Creed

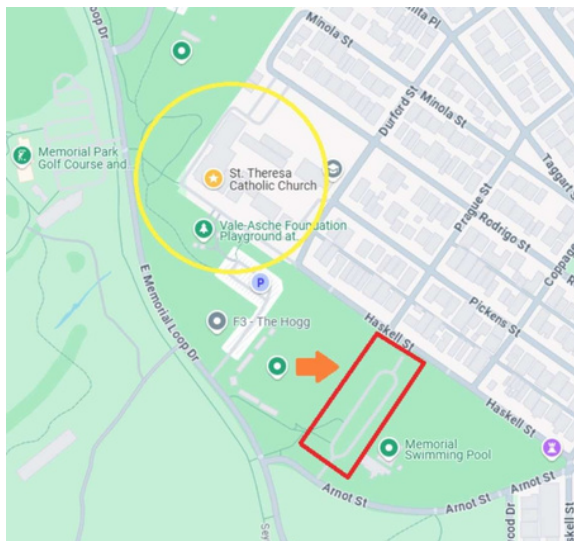
