Readings and Readers

For the <u>readings</u> you will want to choose the following (these are the same for a Wedding with Mass or without Mass at St. Theresa's)

- A 1st Reading from the Old Testament
- A Psalm
- A 2nd Reading from the New Testament (excluding the Gospels)
- A Gospel Reading that the priest or deacon will read
- You will also need to choose **readers** for the following:
 - o one for the 1st reading
 - Regarding the Psalm:
 - If you are having a wedding with Mass, the cantor will sing the Psalm.
 - If you are having a wedding without Mass and have a cantor serving at your wedding, the cantor will sing the Psalm.
 - If you are having a wedding without Mass and do not have a cantor, then you need to have a reader for the Psalm. You will choose your Psalm as part of the music selections form.
 - o one for the 2nd reading
 - o If your wedding is at St Theresa's, readers do not need to be Catholic, but need to feel comfortable reading in front of others and able to read clearly. If you are having your wedding at another church, please check with them if they require the readers to be Catholic and how many readings one may have with a wedding without Mass as some churches may vary.
