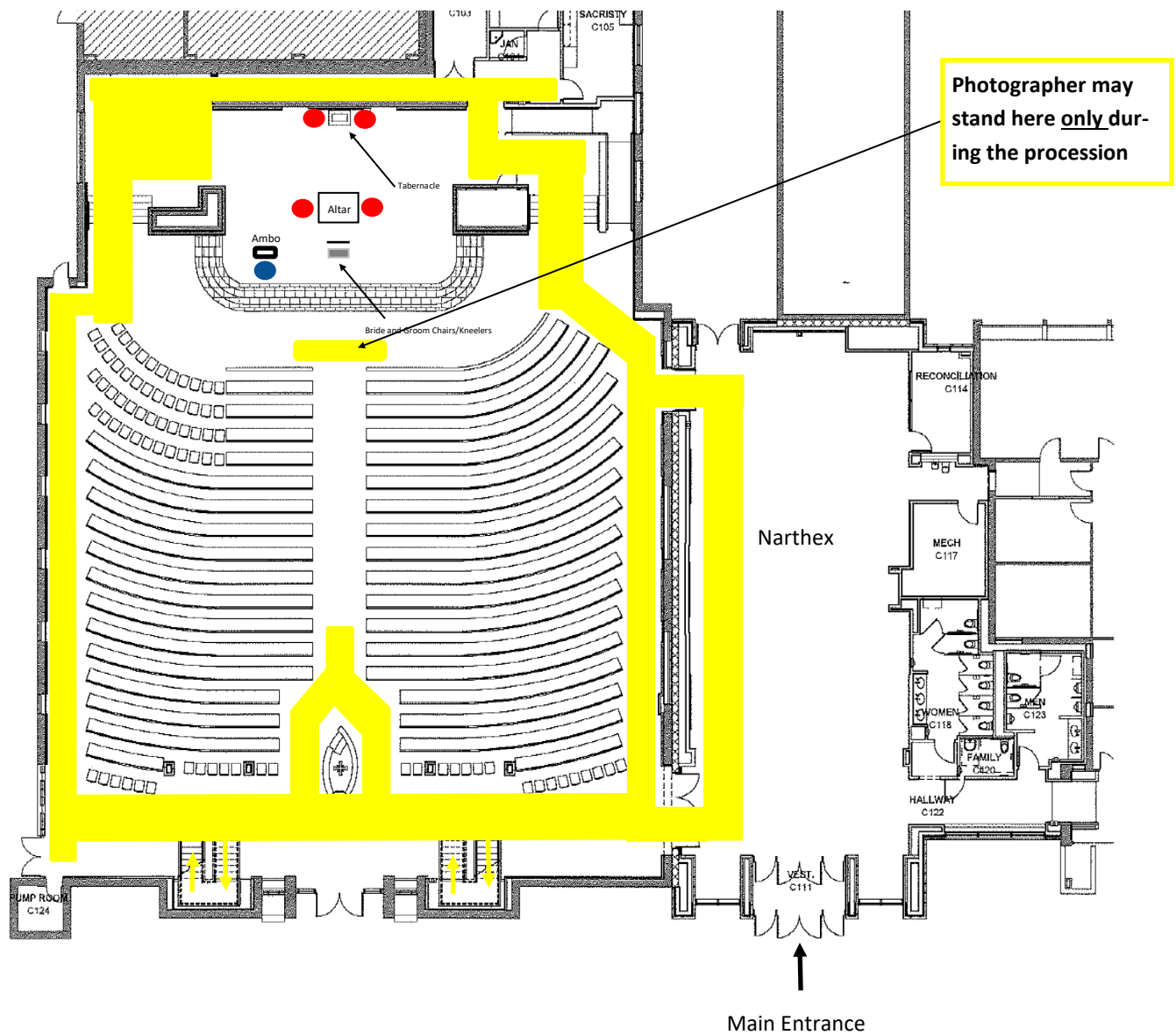


Photography and Videography

Your photographer must be informed of the following guidelines.

1. Photographer and videographer need to check in with the wedding coordinator prior to taking pictures and/or videos.
2. Because we need to clean and disinfect the church prior to the 5pm Saturday Mass for the public we ask that everyone be out of the church by 3:40pm. We ask that all decorations be removed as well. We realize this does not leave much time for pictures after your wedding. You are encouraged to take pictures before your wedding if you would like. **Pictures may be taken in the church up to 45 minutes prior to the ceremony or 30 minutes immediately following your wedding, assuming your wedding began at 2pm.**
3. Flash photography may not be taken **during** the wedding liturgy.
4. The photographer and videographer should not freely roam throughout the church or sanctuary during the liturgy. They may not go on the steps to the main sanctuary. They may go into the side chapels and through a back corridor. An ideal place from which to take photos during the liturgy is the choir loft; however, care should be taken to not interfere with the musicians. **See floorplan of the church below—yellow highlights are where photographer and videographer may be.**
5. Flash pictures are permitted as the wedding party leaves the Church and after the liturgy as well as before the liturgy.
