



## QUALIFIED CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION

Are you required to take a distribution from your IRA this year and don't need the money for living expenses? If you are 70 1/2 or older, a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a great way for you to make a gift to support St. Mary Parish. QCD gifts can make a huge difference to our parish and its efforts to nourish our community!

The key provisions are:

- Donors 70 1/2 or older can transfer up to \$100,000 directly from their IRA annually.
- Qualifying individuals can make charitable gifts directly to a charity using pre-tax IRA assets rather than taking a distribution, paying income taxes, and using after-tax assets to make a charitable gift.
- For a QCD to count towards your current year's required minimum distribution (RMD), the funds must come out of your IRA by your RMD deadline, generally December 31.





## **HOT TAKE**

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. When we think of the Holy Family, as Catholics, I think most of us think of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is rightly so, but we also don't want to lose sight of the importance of Joseph, his role in the Holy Family, and what we can learn from him. So many of the saints are such eloquent speakers and writers. St. Paul was an incredible evangelist. the Venerable Fulton Sheen was such a lecturer, and Pope Benedict XVI was an eloquent writer. These things were not the case for St. Joseph, at least that we are aware of. St. Joseph has no quotes in scripture nor does he have any written works that we know of. So what exactly can we learn from him or even know about him for that matter? Firstly, we know he was a righteous man who chose to save Mary's life instead of having her stoned to death (the punishment for her becoming pregnant out of wedlock). We also know that he trusted God because once it was revealed to him that Mary became pregnant by the Holy Spirit, he believed God's angel and stayed with Mary. Another thing that I find amazing is that we have no record of what Jesus was doing between age 12 and age 30 (when his public ministry began). During this time, presumably, Jesus would have been working with his father who was a carpenter. Jesus was taught how to be a man by Joseph. Think about that, Joseph (along with Mary) taught Jesus, who is God, how to live. Lastly, St. Joseph's holiness is said to be so great that the Church has given him the nickname "terror of demons". So today as we celebrate the Holy Family, make sure you give Jesus and Mary their due, but don't forget to tip your cap to St. Joseph as well. God bless! -David

## **ELEMENTARY FAITH FORMATION**

## **QUESTION OF THE WEEK**

On the night of Jesus' birth in Bethlehem, the shepherds came to the stable to see if the message was true that they received from the angels. As revealed to them, they found the infant lying in a manger wrapped in swaddling clothes. How wonderful it must have been for Mary to hear their incredible story.

Following Jewish law, the parents took Jesus to the Temple eight days later to present him to the Lord. While Mary and Joseph were there, they met Simeon. He was an upright and devout man. God promised that he would not experience death until he set eyes on the Christ, the Anointed One. They met Anna too. She was an older woman who prayed in the temple day and night. Simeon and Anna proclaimed Jesus as Israel's salvation to all who would listen.

Mary believed what God had promised her. So much had happened since giving her "yes" to God nine months earlier—Joseph taking her into his home, the king's order for a census, making the long trip to Bethlehem, having no place to stay at the inn, giving birth to her Son in a stable, the message of the Shepherds, and the visit of the Wise Men. Simeon and Anna spoke of Jesus' greatness. Mary pondered all these things in her heart. "To ponder" means to meditate on something carefully. Pondering together with prayer can lead to understanding.

Looking at her beautiful baby boy and hearing what people said of him must have affirmed Mary's faith and trust in God. There was little room for doubt that things were going according to His plan.

God may not send shepherds, wise men, or prophets to us, but if we keep our eyes and ears open, we might discover God's messengers in our lives. These people affirm our faith and let us know that all is well. Like Mary, we must remember those moments, reflecting and praying about them often in our hearts, especially when life's difficulties test our faith.

When have I pondered events in my life in light of God's plan? Who have been the messengers of God's plan for me?


