HOT TAKE

We are less than a week away from the first college football games of 2025 kicking off. This is always an exciting time of the year, especially here in Texas. One thing that is interesting about college football is that the top teams are all ranked in the "Top 25." A new Top 25 comes out weekly until the conclusion of the season. At the end of the year, it is pretty clear where each team ranks because they have played each other and a champion has emerged from the playoff. But what I find interesting is the initial rankings. This is called the "Preseason Top 25." Teams are ranked in the same way, but all of the ranks are based on what sports writers and coaches think each team will be like this season. There is no scientific method for this. Ultimately, it is a guessing game, and teams that were highly ranked end up being unranked, while unranked teams often end up in the top ten of the rankings. The true quality of the teams reveal themselves as the season goes on. I can't help but think this correlates to our faith. I think we often rank or judge people based on a quick assessment of them. Maybe we had a good encounter or a really bad one. Often these encounters happened years ago, before people changed for the better, but in our minds they hold the same "ranking" as they did five or ten years ago. Many times, celebrities we adore are revealed to have secret dark sides, or they have quietly been running charities and helping the poor. The people in our daily lives are not any different than celebrities in this way. So my challenge is simple: Are we still holding on to preconceived thoughts and judgments of others, or are we open to the changes and developments they have made over their "seasons"? Because one day, God willing, when we make it to heaven, I think you might be surprised who is ranked among the Saints. God Bless! -David




