





HOT TAKE

Have you ever been surprisingly prepared for something? For example, someone dangerously cuts you off in traffic, and you react perfectly because you had learned how to handle that situation in your driver's course. Or maybe you knew the answer to a really hard trivia question because of something you remembered from your AP history class in high school. These types of things have happened to me several times in my life, and every time, I am at first surprised, but then I am thankful because I was prepared, even if I thought I was not. This past Thursday, ninety of our teens received the Sacrament of Confirmation. In our diocese, this is a two year process that requires class attendance, service, and paperwork. It was such a beautiful celebration of the sacrament. I think many of us unintentionally think of sacraments like Baptism, Confirmation, and Matrimony as being a one time event. Your confirmation or baptism may have happened years ago, and it was great, but that happened then and this is now. Well, our faith teaches that the graces we receive in the sacraments are abundant and lasting. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit that we receive at Confirmation are continually offered to us and are working within us as long as we are practicing Catholics who are seeking the Lord. The gifts of knowledge, wisdom, understanding, counsel, piety, courage, and fear of the Lord are guiding us and shaping our lives. Just a couple of days ago, a woman asked me a very deeply religious question that no theology class could have prepared me for, but I was able to respond in an honest and articulate way that brought her comfort and challenged her to seek the Lord. I would say I was surprised that I was prepared to answer such a question, but actually I am not surprised at all, as my Confirmation and Baptism prepared me for moments like this. So, congratulations to the newly confirmed, and remember that this day is not a one time event, but a moment that will prepare and change you for the rest of your life. Be blessed -David


