HOT TAKE

War, drugs, lust, greed, and so on—if you look around our world, you can see all of these things. If you turn on the news, that is basically all they talk about the entire time. To be honest, it can be quite depressing and discouraging. It is so easy to focus on all the bad in the world, but what about all the good? Today we begin a new faith formation year. We will have around 200 students at Life Teen tonight and another 100 or so in Chosen, our Confirmation class. On Wednesday, we will welcome another 130 students to EDGE, our junior high youth group. Across all of our programs, we have over 50 volunteers. It is incredible to see the desire these students and adults have for the Lord. There is a growing openness to God, to morality, and to truth. This is greater than what I have seen in previous generations. We just witnessed the canonization of the first millennial saint, Carlo Acutis, on September 7... a saint who was born just one year before I was! We have a pope who is an American and who connects deeply with us. He has brought great joy and passion to his first few months as pontiff. For the first time in our parish's more than one hundred year history, we have a parochial vicar, Father Simon, residing here at St. Mary. We have an incredible community, not only here at the parish, but also in the greater League City area. My heart is full of excitement and joy as I prepare to encounter each student, parent, and volunteer in this new faith formation year. Yes, there is bad news, and at times, it seems like there is a lot of it. But there is also so much good news in the world. Specifically, in the world of the Catholic faith. You do not have to look far. Just look around this incredible parish and if you still do not feel like you are seeing it, maybe it is time to start volunteering with our youth ministry program or another ministry here at St. Mary. If you do volunteer here I promise you will find the good you are looking for. Be blessed. -David


We work hard to keep tuition and expenses down so that our school continues to be as affordable as possible. Tuition revenue does not cover the entire operating budget of the school. The average annual cost for St. Mary Catholic School to educate a child is \$10,400. The average yearly tuition cost for a parent of a St. Mary Catholic School student is \$7,300. The Annual Fund helps to make up that crucial difference and assists with contributing to the school's operating budget. This includes safety and security upgrades, technology upgrades, professional development, teacher salaries, library upgrades, and Cargill Hall upgrades. 
