

Next weekend, we will take up a collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or working in the federal government beyond U.S. borders – including those from our own parish and diocese.

Including families, AMS priests and deacons serve approximately 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and U.S. territories. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid by the U.S. Government, the AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military for programs and administrative costs. 



HOT TAKE

Who is the God of your life? Do you have any false idols? If you are like me, the answer is always, "No, of course I don't." But is that really the case? Let me explain. This year, Texas introduced a new law that bans phones in schools. That got me thinking about my own screen time and how I might need to limit the time I spend on my phone as well. Teens average seven to nine hours of screen time a day. I average about four. I try to spin this in a positive way by saying things like, "I use my phone for work," or "Sometimes I have a TV show on while I do the dishes and that adds to my total screen time. So, four hours isn't too bad." I know other people make similar excuses, but let's do some quick math. If teens (and many adults) average around eight hours of screen time a day and sleep for eight hours, that means half of their waking hours—eight out of sixteen—are spent on screens. That breaks down to about thirty minutes of every hour. Do you really want your phone or other technology like video games to take up half of your day? Even if you are "only" at four hours like me, that still means twenty-five percent of your waking hours are spent on a screen. For me, this was a wake-up call. I had to ask myself: Do I really want a quarter of my day spent staring at a screen, even if it's "for work"? No, I don't worship my phone, social media, or work. But I do think it's worth asking: If something takes up twenty-five to fifty percent of your day, could it be an idol in your life? Let's be honest—you probably aren't going to get rid of your phone or Netflix. But what if you just cut down one and a half minutes of screen time from every waking hour and dedicated that time to prayer? If you did that, you would add nearly twenty-five minutes to your daily prayer life. If you do that, I promise you will notice a difference and you will feel more connected to our Lord.
