





HOT TAKE

I was talking with someone I am close to recently, and they shared something that was weighing on their mind. They said, "I'm not saying that I do not want to live and I am not suicidal, but I am not sure if I really like living in this world." When I asked more about it, he said, "Is life really just work (and this person has a job he really enjoys), bills, and then eventually death?" He explained that many of the things he once enjoyed are still fun, but they no longer bring lasting happiness. I think many of us feel the same way, though we may not always put it into words. I believe there are two answers to this. First, nothing can fill the God sized hole in our hearts. Only God can bring true fulfillment. Sadly, this person is not a practicing Christian (please pray for him), so he faces the weight of life without a steady relationship with Christ. As St. Augustine said, "Our hearts are restless until they rest in you, Lord." Second, what do we give meaning to? Over the years I have learned that things which may not really matter can still matter as much as we allow them to. As long as we keep Christ first, the other things in life matter only to the extent that they bring joy, meet a need (such as work to pay bills), or draw us closer to God. Yes, playing Pokemon cards may seem childish, but if it brings joy, then play. I love watching football. The world does not need football to exist, but I find joy in cheering for my team. So if you are feeling like my friend, struggling with purpose, ask yourself two questions. First, am I putting God first and giving Him the time needed to build a relationship with Him? Second, what brings me joy, and can I give that meaning? As long as it matters to you, it does not matter what the rest of the world thinks. Be blessed-David






