## ACTS Retreats - Frequently Asked Questions

#### What is an ACTS Retreat?

An ACTS Retreat is held for three days and three nights and is presented by fellow parishioners. The retreat begins on Thursday evening and ends the following Sunday at a Mass celebrated with the Parish Community. Retreats for men and women are given separately. The focus for the weekend is Adoration, Community, Theology, and Service from which the ACTS acronym is derived. The retreat takes on the traditions and atmosphere of the Parish Community sponsoring it. The retreat facilitates the attainment of a new and/or deeper relationship with the Lord through:

Adoration – the call by, acceptance of, and response to God;
Community – the love and caring of others;
Theology – the study of God through scripture and the Catholic Faith;
Service – to God and his people.

Each retreat is conducted by a retreat "team" composed of individuals who have attended prior ACTS retreats. Chosen by the retreat Director and Co-Directors, the team organizes the retreat, conducts the retreat activities, and ministers to the needs of the retreatants during the retreat weekend.

### What is the purpose of an ACTS retreat?

To allow each retreatant to experience God's love and joy and deepen their faith in Him. To allow all to return to their lives with a deeper love for God, each other, and a desire to become more involved in their faith community and serve others.

### Why attend an ACTS retreat?

It is a powerful and enduring personal conversion experience. Over the weekend retreatants experience a better understanding of God's love and His presence in their lives and the journey that He has planned for each of us. Retreatants come away with a new and renewed dedication to live their life as Jesus did by recognizing the needs of those around us and of our obligation, as followers of Christ, to help meet those needs.
