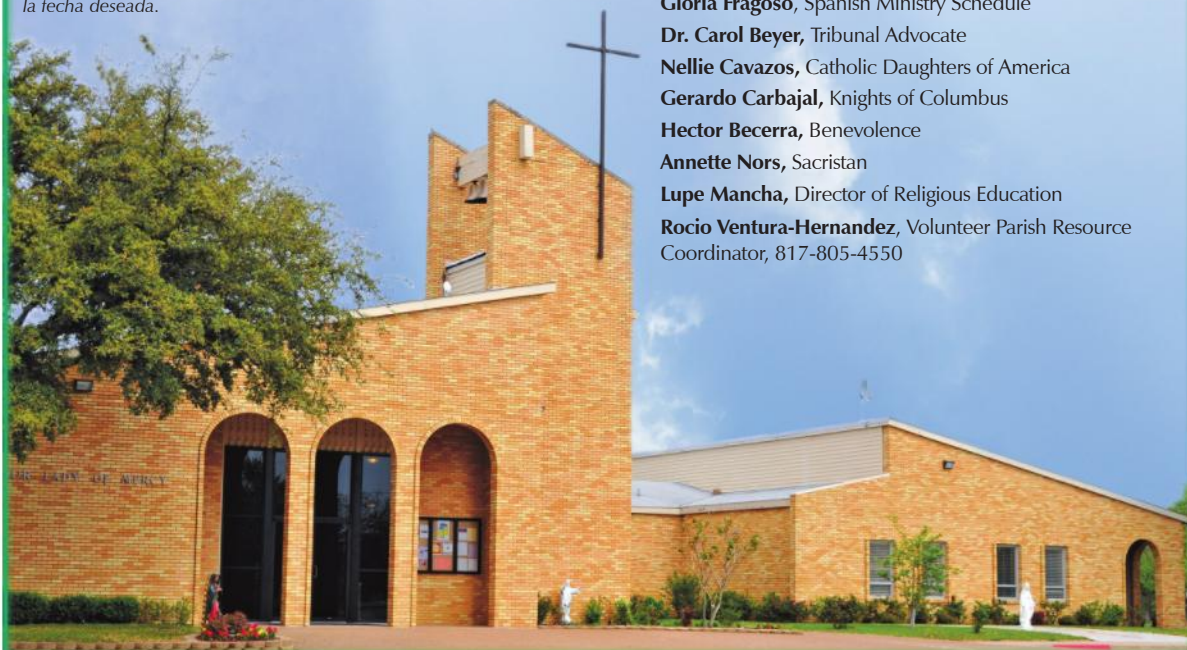

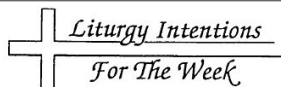


The Holy Family, with Saint Joseph Embracing the Christ Child by Carlo Maratta

REFLECTION/REFLEXIÓN

We live in a society where we can easily be trapped by various types of fear: fear of death, fear of being robbed, fear of war or of terrorist attacks, fear of becoming ill. Globalization and technology get us even closer to the pain and human misery so many people, both near and far from us, experience every day. Today's readings invite us to confront our fears with faith and hope: Jesus sleeps in the boat during a storm because he trusts that it will not sink, and Saint Paul reminds us that those who live in Christ are a new creation called to proclaim that there is hope in a new reality. It is helpful for community groups to use some of these biblical texts to discuss the dichotomy between fear and faith during their weekly meetings. Fear extinguishes faith, but the word of God can illuminate our lives so that Jesus, with his light, can guide the way.

Vivimos en una sociedad en la que podemos quedarnos atrapados fácilmente por varios tipos de miedo: miedo a la muerte, miedo a que nos roben, miedo a la guerra o ataques terroristas, miedo a enfermar. La globalización y la tecnología nos acercan aún más al dolor y la miseria humana que tantas personas, tanto cercanas como lejanas, experimentan cada día. Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a afrontar nuestros miedos con fe y esperanza: Jesús duerme en la barca durante una tormenta porque confía en que no se hundirá, y san Pablo nos recuerda que los que viven en Cristo son una nueva creación llamada a anunciar que hay esperanza en una nueva realidad. Es útil para los grupos comunitarios usar algunos de estos textos bíblicos para discutir la dicotomía entre el miedo y la fe durante sus reuniones semanales. El miedo extingue la fe, pero la palabra de Dios puede iluminar nuestra vida para que Jesús, con su luz, guíe el camino. Liturgy.com

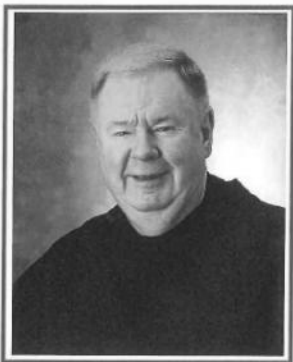

Brother John Patrick Calvey, T.O.R 76, member of the Third Order Regular Franciscans, Province of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Died on, Wednesday, March 24, 2021 at Saint Francis Friary at Mount Assisi in Loretto, Pennsylvania after a brief illness. Born On April 28, 1944 in Scranton PA, the son of the late John Jennings and Kathryn (Dailey) Calvey. Brother John Patrick entered the Third Order Regular in August of 1989 at Mt. Assisi Friary in Loretto,

PA. At the end of his novitiate year he professed first vows on June 1, 1991, and later professed Solemn Vows on July 1, 1995. Brother John served as pastoral assistant at Our Lady of Mercy from 2003 to 2008. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace.
