Second Sunday of Lent

February 25, 2024

Greetings!

DSA: This week, all registered parishioners will receive a letter from me inviting you to participate in the 2024 Diocesan Services Appeal. Our annual commitment to the DSA is an important component of being a disciple of Jesus. I pray that our participation level will increase this year.

As I announced a few weeks ago, Ben Koval, our Director of Music Ministry, has recently announced that he will leave St. Gerard at the end of June as his family relocates for his wife's new job. Ben has been an excellent addition to our Pastoral Staff, and while we will miss him greatly, we wish his family all the best in the next chapter of their lives.

Important Parish Update: After much prayer and discernment, I am happy to announce that **Olivia**



Vargas has been offered and accepted the Interim Director of Music position at St. Gerard. Olivia has worked in music ministry at St. Gerard since 2018; she is already an essential member of our music ministry. Olivia currently directs the Children's Choir and the Alive Ensemble at the 6 pm

Mass. Olivia graduated from Aquinas College with a Bachelor of Music in Liturgical Music in 2018 with an emphasis in voice and secondary instruments of piano and organ. I am excited to see the new dimensions that Olivia will bring to our music program at St. Gerard. The position is considered interim because we plan to revisit the newly updated ministry/job description next spring. Congratulations Olivia!

School Scoop: Were you on campus last Thursday evening? If so, you might have heard quite a commotion in the school gym. Following a hardfought game, our 6th grade girls' team earned a



thrilling victory over St. Patrick, Portland, by just one point, breaking the Shamrock's impressive two-and-a-half-year win streak. Congratulations Falcons! We face them again in a couple of weeks on their home court in an upcoming tournament.

Mass Matters: Why are the Gloria and Alleluia omitted during Lent? One of our astute young members asked this question after last week's Mass. Just as we observe personal fasting and reflection during Lent, the liturgy also "fasts" in anticipation of Easter. During the Lenten season, you will notice two stark omissions from the liturgy: the hymn known as the *Gloria* (Glory to God in

the Highest) and the **Alleluia** verse sung before the Gospel, both of which are not permitted throughout the entire 40 days of Lent, with a few exceptions.

The Gloria is a hymn that rejoices in the Lord's coming, echoing the words of the angels at Christ's birth. During Lent, the Church spiritually retraces a time when God's people were in exile, longing for the promised Messiah. This period of expectation parallels Advent, although instead of anticipating Christ's birth from Mary's womb, Christians await His second "birth" from the tomb.

Following the theme of exile, the Church recalls the wanderings of Moses and the Israelites in the desert for 40 years. This time symbolizes agony and purification, echoing the sentiment of the faithful in Psalm 137:4, "How shall we sing the Lord's song in a foreign land?" The term "Alleluia" stems from a Hebrew expression meaning "praise the Lord" and is therefore omitted during Lent.

Season of Preparation: Our parish is bustling with activity as many individuals enter more intense sacramental preparations. Following the celebration of their first Reconciliation, many of our young ones are now getting ready for their First Eucharist this Spring. Our junior high-aged youth are diligently preparing for Confirmation. Additionally, a group of men and women of various ages are preparing to enter more deeply into the Church's Sacramental life. Last Saturday, those seeking to celebrate these sacraments during the Easter Season participated in the rite of Election and Recognition with Bishop Boyea. Let us continue to pray for all these believers as they journey in faith.


HELP NEEDED FOR OUR SUNDAY HOMEBOUND MINISTRY!
