Dear Parish Family,

This time of year can find many of us quite busy, especially families with children involved in various activities. Take time for spiritual renewal before letting this sacred season of Lent pass you by. Our bulletin continues to be an excellent resource for many opportunities throughout these weeks. Please read it. Seeing so many participate in Evening Prayer, Soup and Substance, Reconciliation, and Stations of the Cross has been great.

SCRUTINIES: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA, or sometimes OCIA) is the process by which adults and older children enter into full communion with the Catholic Church. We are blessed to have several individuals preparing to join the Catholic Church this Spring. Over the next three weeks, those preparing for baptism will be participating in the three Scrutiny Rites. The scrutinies help these men and women reflect on their lives, repent of sin, and seek God's strength to overcome the power of sin in their lives. The Christian Community, in turn, is invited to pray for these individuals. The Gospel readings for these next three weeks are explicitly chosen to help these individuals reflect on their conversion to Christ. May we all follow their example and listen to how God calls each of us to a more profound conversion this Lent.

Strategic Planning: With direction and support from the Parish Pastoral Council, the parish pastoral staff have been working on strategic planning. Strategic planning is essential for St. Gerard, just like any organization, because it helps define a clear direction and priorities for growth. Our strategic planning process has identified three pastoral priorities for St. Gerard Parish:

Engage and disciple parents of school-aged children. Create and foster existing small groups in our parish. Beautiful and engaging Liturgies.

Note, of course, that naming these three priorities does not mean that matters outside their scope are not a priority. Certainly, as a Catholic Parish, we have many other essential priorities that are already built into our leadership structure. The strategic planning process, however, helps us focus on opportunities that otherwise might go unaddressed. Please continue to pray for our parish as we seek to do God's will and participate in His work. If you have comments or ideas regarding these priorities, please feel free to share them with a member of the Pastoral Council, Parish Staff, or myself.

Liturgical Ministries: In alignment with priority #3, we are working to strengthen the experience and role of

our various liturgical ministries (ex., servers, ushers, lectors). Our current liturgical ministers are an asset to our Sunday experience; this priority only seeks to build upon what is already happening. We will begin by focusing on our usher and greeter ministry.

Usher/Greeter Ministry: The role of ushers and greeters is an integral part of the Sunday experience. These ministries are all the more essential for a parish the size of St. Gerard. Please consider joining our usher or greeter teams; **we need additional volunteers.** All current ushers/greeters or those interested in these ministries are asked to attend one of two upcoming meetings: Wednesday, March 13, or Thursday, March 14, from 6:30 pm - 8:00 pm in the Parish Hall. 


RCIA: THE FIRST SCRUTINY



Today at the 11 am Mass, the adults preparing for baptism (called "the elect") participate in the first of three "Scrutiny Rites". Scrutiny Rites are ceremonies by which the Elect examine their lives in order to be free to fully accept the Lord's saving power in the waters of

baptism. The word "scrutiny" means a close examination or study. The Elect will closely examine their lives in light of God's Word. What might need to be changed in order to follow Him better? What is getting in the way of having a solid relationship with Him? What are they already doing well that should be affirmed? At the 11 am Mass this weekend, the Gospel we will hear is of John's account of the Woman at the Well (John 4:5-42) instead of the usual 'cycle B' readings. In Jesus' brief encounter with this woman, we see that she has a 'thirst' for things that will not bring her true happiness. What Jesus offers brings eternal happiness! Let us all think about our thirsts this Lenten Season, and renew our thirst for Christ, the only one who can truly quench all our desires. Let us continue to pray for all those preparing to join the Catholic Church this Easter Season!
