Fourth Sunday of Lent

March 10, 2024

Dear Parish Family,

In this fourth week of Lent, we continue our journey of renewal and transformation, trusting in God's mercy and grace. We are now halfway through Lent. How have you focused on prayer, fasting, and almsgiving this year? Keep it up, or start all over again - there is still time to have a great Lent!

In the Gospel of John, we encounter the story of Jesus healing a man blind from birth. Through this miraculous act, Jesus not only restores the man's physical sight but also opens his eyes to the truth of who Jesus is. The man's journey from blindness to sight mirrors our journey of faith, as we are called to see and understand God's presence and love in our lives. We pray that God will help us open our eyes and see his presence.

"Behold the man!": these are words with which Pilate presented Jesus, beaten and crowned with thorns, to his accusers (John 19:5). This is the scene depicted in the stunning painting displayed in the back of our church near the St. Anthony statue. In the background, you will notice depictions of the many sufferings that people experience in their lives today,



reminding us to unite our sufferings with Christ and that He is present with us through them. This painting typically hangs in the south confessional room but has been brought to the main Church for Lent. I came across this image online in 2015 and wrote the artist (Irene Thomas) requesting to purchase a small copy of the painting. To my surprise, she sent me the original and asked only for prayers for her family.

Faith of a child: I met with the 2nd graders preparing for First Communion and their parents last weekend. It gives me so **much hope** to see the excitement in their eyes as they get closer to the day they will be able to receive Jesus in the Eucharist (April 20). I am thankful to our parents and catechists for their commitment to nurturing the spiritual lives of these young ones.

Cabrini: This new major motion picture, which tells the story of the first American-born canonized saint, was released this past week. This movie is getting great



RCIA THE SECOND SCRUTINY



Today at the 11 am Mass, the adults preparing for baptism (called "the Elect") participate in the second of three "Scrutiny Rites". Scrutiny Rites are ceremonies by which the

Elect examine their lives in order to be free to fully accept the Lord's saving power in the waters of baptism. The word "scrutiny" means a close examination or study. The Elect will closely examine their lives in light of God's Word. What might need to be changed in order to follow Him better? What is getting in the way of having a solid relationship with Him? What are they already doing well that should be affirmed? The Gospel we will hear this weekend is of John's account of the Man Born Blind (John 9:1-41). Though the man persists in telling the truth of his story that Jesus healed him, the Pharisees remain 'blind' to the idea that Jesus could actually be the Messiah. Though it is the Elect who directly participate in this Rite, the rest of us can benefit by examining our own lives. What blessings are you missing out on because of 'blindness' in your life? Let us take some time to pray and closely examine our lives so we can grow together in Christ with the Elect.






