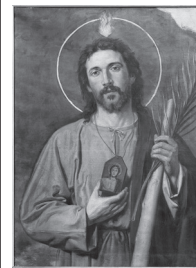

Thank you for helping us adorn the altar with beauty and thanksgiving!



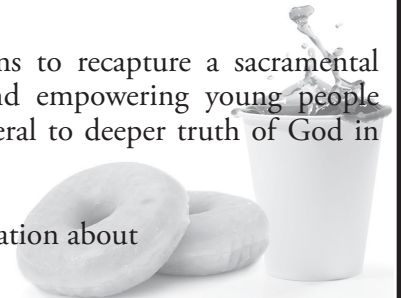
Bethany Ministry
