CONDUCT, PLACE, AND TIME

CONDUCT: Leaders/volunteers at this event may ask an attendee of the dance to leave if attire, behavior, or speech are considered inappropriate based on our judgment. **No refunds.** No provocative dancing.

DRESS CODE:

Ladies: No shorts. Dresses and skirts are expected to be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. **(If this is continually not followed, the new requirement will be below the knee!!)** No bare backs, midriffs, tanks, no leggings worn by themselves, and no exposed cleavage. If you wear pants, they should not be too tight - a longer shirt that's loose should be worn on top. Shorts are needed under skirts for skirts that rise above the knee when you spin. Stomach should not show when you raise your arms.

Gentlemen: No shorts. No tight pants. No tank tops.

Students will be permitted to attend class the first time that the dress code is violated, but parents will be contacted within 24 hrs and the students will be expected to dress accordingly in the future.

CLASS EXPECTATIONS:

Students are expected to be attentive to the instructor! Parents will be contacted if students are being continually disruptive. Students are expected to engage in the social dance time according to the instructor's expectations. **(All boys will ask the girls to dance until every girl has danced at least once.)**

Intermediate class will run 8:00-8:30 p.m. Beginner class will run 8:30-9:00 p.m. Combined social dance time is 9:00-9:45 p.m. **All students must leave campus by 10:00 p.m.!** Students who are waiting for their class to begin can wait in the pavilion. Intermediate students will wait in the pavilion during the beginner class. No wondering around campus. All students must be in either St. Jude Hall or the St. Jude Pavilion at all times, where we will have chaperones.
