### Dear Sacred Heart parishioners,

Last week I wrote to you concerning my responsibility as your pastor to know my parishioners. Another of my responsibilities is to administer the parish's temporal goods, meaning the parish's funds and facilities. Just as most dads are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their homes, I also have to do the same for our parish. I am a steward of your resources that you generously share with the parish, and I strive to use them in the most efficient way possible. I must make sure that our buildings are kept up well, that our expenses are covered with the income that the parish has, and to look for ways to improve on the good things that we have.

I am assisted in this responsibility by two groups of parishioners. The parish Finance Council meets at least quarterly. It reviews the parish's financial statements, helps me to budget for future expenses, and helps to plan for capital improvement projects as needed. The Finance Council is made up of Charles Boyers, Bill Gilligan, James Horstkamp, Tammy Pilkerton, and Margaret Williams.

I have also convened a Facilities Committee to assist me and Eric Gibson, who often will do projects for our church, to keep our parish grounds and buildings looking their best. This committee consists of Charles Beaver, Bennie Combs, Glenn Hall, Charlie Lacey, Charlie Pilkerton, and C.D. Raley (no, being named "Charles" was not a prerequisite for being on the committee!) This committee helps me to look at our facilities, suggests needed upgrades, and helps with small projects as needed. I am very grateful for the contribution of the members of both committees, because they have expertise that is useful for advising me and making our parish the best that it can be.

The rectory renovations are progressing well. The former walls, which were a combination of pressed cardboard and wood paneling, have been removed, and drywall is being installed in all of the rooms. I will continue to keep you posted as the work progresses.
