Dear Sacred Heart Family,

Last week we ended the Christmas Season. This can sometimes get us down as we conclude a wonderful time of year that makes us feel so good. However, as today's Gospel makes clear, our Christian life is not just about us and how we feel and what we get out of it – it is about responding to a call from the Lord to follow him. At his baptism, Jesus is revealed as the Son of God who is sent on a mission by the Father, to "be a light to the nations" that "salvation might reach the ends of the earth" as Isaiah the prophet explains in the first reading. At our baptisms, we too are sent on a mission, to bring the Good News of salvation in Jesus Christ to others. Others need to hear this news, and God is asking us to bring it to them.

What is this Good News? First and foremost, that every human being is created uniquely by God, and in Jesus Christ, each of us can be adopted by God as His son or daughter. What great dignity each human life has! Yet, our society and culture need to hear this good news. Beginning next Saturday, January 21st, Catholics and other Christians around the country will begin a 9 Days for Life Novena, which includes the opportunity to pray, to share items on social media, and to learn about the dignity of every human life. Through this Novena, we can all accept our mission given to us by Jesus Christ in our baptism, to bring His Good News to our community and society and culture.

I invite you to participate in this Novena (which I will post to Facebook and also print out and make available), by praying in a special way during these 9 days, by finding the courage to share posts about the dignity of life through your Facebook or Instagram or Twitter pages, and by educating yourself on why we believe certain actions that the culture thinks are normal really do damage the dignity of human life made in God's image and likeness.
