The last two weekends have also been ones of great blessing for our Archdiocese. On Saturday, June 17th, Cardinal Wuerl ordained 4 new priests and on Saturday, June 24th, he ordained 11 new permanent deacons. While we are blessed with these new priests and deacons, we here at Sacred Heart parish and neighboring Holy Angels parish are still sharing one priest. Another priest was not assigned this year, and next year the priestly ordination class will also be small. First, this means we need to pray for more vocations! If we each offer a prayer every day for this blessing, that a young man from our own family will hear and pursue the call from Jesus, I know that the Lord will answer! A prayer is included in this bulletin below.

However, considering this reality and with Deacon Lloyd's permission, I asked the Cardinal this spring to expand Deacon Lloyd's assignment to include Sacred Heart parish. And as of June 30th, Deacon Lloyd's ministry will expand to encompass Sacred Heart. I am very grateful for Deacon Lloyd's enthusiasm and also for the Cardinal's willingness to permit this. The two parishes are still separate and distinct, but now in addition to sharing one priest, they will also share one deacon. Deacon Lloyd is a great blessing and he will now also be able to assist me in my ministry to Sacred Heart.

Our parish council has also been meeting for several weeks to identify the current challenges facing our parish and to recommend immediate and long-term goals to make sure our parish can continue to thrive in its mission to bring the light of the Gospel to our community and to be the means by which men and women enter into communion with God. We hope to be able to share these goals with the parish in the coming months.

One of the ways we continue this mission is through prayer. Without close union with our Lord, none of our works, no matter how many, will bear any fruit. So this coming First Friday, we are offering 24 hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. A group in St. Mary's county is helping parishes throughout the county offer this special time of prayer. A sign up sheet is in the back of church, but I have also posted a website on Facebook where you can also sign up. But feel free

to stop by at any time from 7am on Friday to 7am on Saturday to come spend time with Jesus and pray for vocations and for our parish that we can discern what the Lord is asking us to do to fulfill our mission.

Finally, Holy Angels is hosting a Parish Potluck Picnic for the community. Please know that Sacred Heart parishioners are invited to attend as well.

As we continue our summer, I pray that we may also grow in our faith by learning to relax not just with our families but also with the Lord!
