All are invited to celebrate these most sacred days of our liturgical year.

A year ago, we were unable to even gather for Holy Week liturgies. This year, we are grateful we can gather together to celebrate the Lord's passion, death and resurrection, **yet we still need to be vigilant**. Social distancing will be observed, and the use of face coverings is still encouraged.

Holy Thursday, April 1 - 7 pm - We begin these special days with foot washing, celebration of the Eucharist and adoration. A suggested schedule for adoration is 8-9 pm last names begin with M-Z and 9-10 pm last names begin A-L. However, any time one is able to spend with the Lord is encouraged.

Good Friday, April 2 - 7 pm - Today we proclaim the Passion from the Gospel of John who portrays Jesus as one very much in control, yet gives his life for the glory of his Father. We pray for many people throughout the world and venerate the cross. We receive Holy Communion that was consecrated on Holy Thursday.

Easter Vigil, April 3 - 9 pm - We begin outside the Parish Center with a new fire and light our new Easter Candle. We carry the flame inside and listen to the stories of salvation history. We make our way to the church to renew our baptismal promises and celebrate of the Eucharist.

Easter Sunday, April 4 - 9 am - We continue our Easter Celebration of Christ's victory over death by his resurrection. Children may bring their Easter baskets and place them in front of the altar to be blessed. After Mass there will be an Easter Egg hunt.

Preparation of the church for Easter will be at 10 am Saturday, April 3. The Liturgy Commission can use several people to help arrange lilies and Easter flowers and someone brave to climb the ladder to hang the curtain by the crucifix.
