From the Pastor's Desk



We are at the second Sunday of Advent and the call to prepare for the coming of the Lord continues as we see it in our gospel this Sunday. When the word of God came to John the Baptist while he was in the desert, he acted on it. He went throughout the entire region of the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance to the people. He said "prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths."

This call also extends to us. Last Sunday I invited you to focus your preparation not only in the material aspect, but also in the spiritual because we are spiritual beings that needs our souls to be nourished and be aware of our calling to care for others as well. Let us admit that sometimes we do not live to the expectations of God because of our weaknesses and self-centeredness. 


