Burning the palms from 2018 for ashes to be placed on the foreheads this Ash Wednesday




Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent and the beginning of a fresh start with the Lord through spiritual and religious meditations. It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday, through which we attain redemption. Palms from last year's Palm Sunday have been burned and the ashes from these palms will be used during today's Ash Wednesday services. The ashes are a symbol of penance made sacramental by the blessing of the Church, and they help us develop a spirit of humility and sacrifice. While the ashes symbolize penance and contrition, they are also a reminder that God is gracious and merciful to those who call on Him with repentant hearts. The custom of placing ashes on the heads of people is an ancient penitential practice. Father will be vested in purple to mark the liturgical season.



During Lent, daily mass will be celebrated on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 8:00 A.M. On Wednesdays, Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 P.M. This will provide an opportunity for the people who work to attend Mass during Lent, in addition to attending on Saturday evening/Sunday morning.



Stations of the Cross - Lenten Adoration of the Cross will be all day on Fridays immediately following the 8:00 A.M. Mass. The Stations of the Cross will be recited at 7:00 P.M.



"Chaplet of the Divine Mercy" - Saturdays/Sundays during Lent, before the 4:00 P.M. Mass (around 3:45 P.M.); before the 8:30 A.M. mass (around 8:15 A.M.) and before the 11:00 A.M. Mass (around 10:45 A.M.), we will sing the "*Chaplet of the Divine Mercy*".
