

## **Let Us Pray**

We hear these words every week at Sunday Liturgy. But do you take them to heart? Ask yourself these questions.

Do you devote time for prayer each day? If not, why not?

How can you improve your prayer life?

How can prayer draw you closer to God?

St. Mary 's Parish will help you answer those questions and more with an eight-part series called *Oremus*, Latin for *Let us Pray*. Start the new year by joining fellow parishioners on Wednesday evenings January 4th through February 22nd from 6:30 to 8:00 P.M. or Monday mornings January 9th through February 27th from 9:00 – 10:30 A.M. in the Fellowship Hall. The Wednesday evening session will be led by our Deacon Candidate, J. T. Tuskan. Using Ascension Press content, including a video presentation from Fr. Mark Toups, and group discussion, the following topics will be covered: 1) What is Prayer? 2) Before You Pray 3) Lectio Divina 4) Relational Prayer 5) Spiritual Senses 6) Discernment in Prayer 7) Distractions 8) Desolation & Consolation. A participant workbook helps with important points from each session, discussion questions and a roadmap for daily prayer between meetings. Next Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent. Advent comes from the Latin word 'Adventus' which means 'coming'. It is the beginning of a new liturgical year in western churches and will last for the four Sundays leading up to Christmas. This is a time of waiting and preparation for the Nativity of Christ but also for the return of Christ at the Second Coming. As we bless the advent wreath and light the first violet candle, we should ask ourselves "What am I doing to prepare myself spiritually for the birth of Jesus?". There are many rich traditions—using an advent wreath at your family table, praying a novena, reading the birth of Jesus in your bible (Matthew or Luke), fasting, attending mass more often, receiving reconciliation. Our bulletin will also have suggestions. «




