SUNDAY, APRIL 14, 2019 PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

- 1) Luke 19:28-40
- 2) Isaiah 50:4-7
- 3) Philippians 2:6-11
- 4) Luke 22:14-23:56 or 23:1-49

<u>FOCUS:</u>We are invited to accompany Jesus as he faces betrayal, abandonment, suffering and death. Today we commemorate the passion of Jesus. Through the Gospel reading, we are invited into the story, to be present with Jesus as he experiences his arrest, suffering and death. We reflect upon the various figures in the Gospel, those who actively contributed to his persecution, those who stood at a distance, and those who would not partake of the evil that was done. As Christians, we are called to remember the events of Palm Sunday whenever we encounter suffering, whether our own or others. LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the procession with palms, Luke recounts the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, where people proclaimed, *Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord*. In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies about the Lord's servant. In the second reading from Philippians, Paul quotes a hymn that tells of the "emptying" and

subsequent exaltation of Christ. In the Gospel, Luke recounts the events of Christ's passion: from the meal with his Apostles, to his agony on the Mount of Olives, and then his arrest, crucifixion, death and burial.

All Are Invited to Attend the Chrism Mass on April 16, 2019: The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at The Cathedral of Our Lady of Victory on April 16, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. During the Mass, Bishop Cahill will bless the Oil of Catechumens, the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Chrism. Traditionally, bishops have blessed oil since the early Church. Since the Bishop is the only minister in the diocese who can consecrate The Oil of Chrism, this Mass highlights his ministry and union with the entire presbyterate. The Chrism Mass will also offer the priests of the diocese the opportunity to publicly renew their priestly promises, in the presence of Bishop Cahill. June 9-14

Fr. Stephen Vacek will lead a 6-day pilgrimage to EWTN (Alabama) by motorcoach. The pilgrimage includes Mass and a visit to St. Anthony of Padua Cathedral in Beaumont; an overnight stay in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; visiting the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament/Our Lady of the Angels Monastery and the tomb of Mother Angelica; attending a live recording of Fr. Mitch Pacwa's show "Scripture & Tradition" and attend Mass at EWTN Studios which will be broadcast live on June 13. The group then returns to Victoria making an overnight stop in New Orleans where they will attend Mass at the National Shrine of the Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos.
