A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who publicly recite the Te Deum in thanksgiving on the last day of the year. A plenary indulgence is also granted to the faithful who publicly recite the hymn: Veni Creator Spiritus on the first day of the year. Therefore, at St. Mary's, we will sing the Te Deum on December 31st at the end of the 4:00pm Vigil Mass of Mary, Mother of God. We will also sing the Veni Creator Spiritus on January 1st at the end of the 10:00am Mass of Mary, Mother of God.

In order to obtain plenary indulgences, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace: have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins; receive the Holy Eucharist; and pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

The Cathedral of Our Lady of Victory will be offering an Adult Confirmation Course this January - February, 2020. This is a class for adult


