### THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

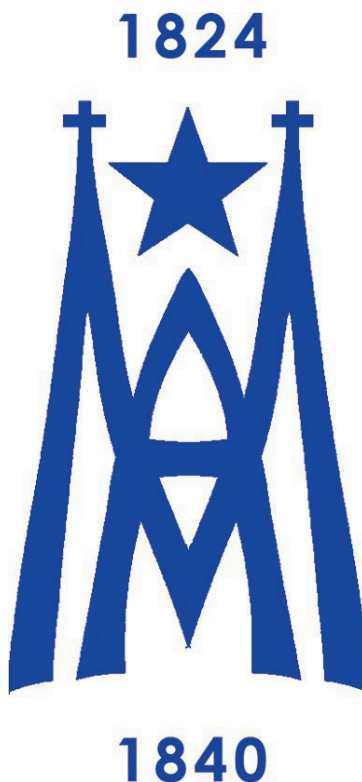

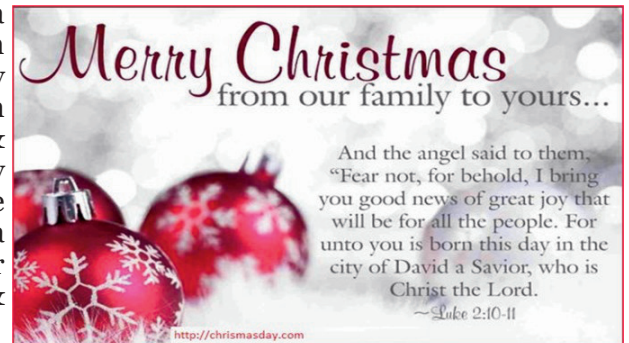
