## The Shape of the Liturgy

Hail to the Lord's Anointed

Our communion hymn today, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, is the hymn Hail to the Lord's Anointed, a well-known hymn was written in 1821 by the by James Montgomery (died 1854), a Scottish abolitionist. It is a transcription into poetic verse of Psalm 72, which is a prophecy of the coming Messiah – foretelling the reign of the King and of what the Kingdom of that King will be like. But more than a prophecy, Psalm 72 is a prayer. In these verses the psalmist calls upon God to give justice and righteousness not only to the King, the crowned earthly king of Israel, but also to the heavenly King, Jesus the Messiah. It is a prayer for the deliverance of a broken people and for the realization of peace and light. As we sing this beautiful hymn, we join in this prayer of hope, of our longing for the coming of the Kingdom of God, for the healing of our broken world, and for the coming into our hearts of the one who turns darkness to light and whose "name to us is Love." As we begin this New Year of 2022, in our broken world of COVID, of confusion, doubt, and in many places of fear, it is appropriate that we begin this New Year with this prayer of hope for a better world of peace and light which the King of Righteousness and Peace has brought into our lives and our world (Heb. 7:2).


#### UNDECORATING THE CHURCH THIS SUNDAY, JANUARY 9TH AT 2:00 PM

#### CHOOSING TO LOVE MARRIAGE RE-TREAT


### FEBRUARY 11-13, 2022
