



The Shape of the Liturgy

Do Whatever He Tells You

This last week in our diocese, we held the Rosary Congress as a time of special prayer before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament using the Holy Rosary to pray for our families, our country, and the world. And this comes at a time of such special need for prayer, and especially for the prayers of Mary, Mother of Christ - the Theotokas - Θεοτοκάς - Mother of the Church, and our own Mother. The family is under assault from the secularism of our society. Our country is under assault (and especially us Catholics) from prejudice, ignorance, and sometimes even hostility toward our Faith. And our world is under assault by "wars and rumors of wars" (Mt. 24:6) which we can see each day on the evening news.

Thus, we turn to Mary our Mother and seek her intercession, just as the first disciples of her Son did at the Marriage in Cana (Jn 2:1-5). And we make this special time of prayer of the Rosary to a Mother who, like all mothers, loves us her children and wants the best for us. In honoring His Mother, we are simply following the example of our Lord Himself, who at the Cross entrusted her to the care of St. John, the "disciple whom he loved" (Jn 20:2), and in doing so he placed us also (the Church) into her care.

And perhaps in our need to live and practice what we preach, we priests stand in special need of her prayers for us under her title Regina Cleri – Queen of Priests.

On 13 June 1917, our Lady - the "Beautiful Lady dressed in White"* - taught the three children (Lúcia dos Santos and her cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto) to say what has become known as the "Fátima Prayer" after each decade of the Rosary. She also encouraged the children to continue daily recitation of the Rosary.

On this Sunday as we honor the Blessed Mother under her title Our Lady of the Rosary, it seems especially appropriate to remember the prayer she has given to us:

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to heaven especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy. Amen.



And we pray this prayer also remembering the words of Mary when she said to the servants at the marriage feast at the wedding in Cana, "Do whatever he (Jesus) tells you." May you and I and all of us always in our minds and hearts and wills, seek first to follow our Lady's instruction here, because He does speak to us in many ways each day – when we are attentive and listening to his voice – that "still, small voice" (I Kings 19:12) the voice of conscience – the Prophet Elijah perceived so long ago.
