PROPOSED TIME LINE FOR SEARCH COMMITTEES

This is a time line for an ideal situation. Whatever the actual dates involved, the process ordinarily takes about four or more months. Director of Religious Education and / or Youth Ministry (DRE / YM) looking for jobs like to check out possibilities in the early spring so that they can move (if needed) and begin to settle by mid-summer so they are ready for the program year.

FEBRUARY (or at least four months before the desired job offer date)

- Pastor / Commission / Board recruits a Search Committee and a Chair of the Search Committee.
- Chair of Search Committee contacts the appropriate Director of the Pastoral Office for Catechesis or the Human Resources Department for any needed assistance.
- Search Committee meets to determine the parish needs, update or develop a position description in order to see what type of candidate would be most appropriate for their parish, and has it reviewed by the Human Resource Department.

MARCH (or at least three months before the desired job offer date)

- Search Committee prepares an application and information packet.
- Search Committee writes ad, has it reviewed by the Human Resource Department, and begins advertising position.

APRIL (or at least two months before the desired job offer date)

- Search Committee sends application information packets to prospective candidates.
- Search Committee begins screening of resumes to review and prioritize applications / resumes.
- Search Committee begins to interview top candidates.
- Search Committee thoroughly checks references and verifies college education of final candidates.

MAY (or at least one month before the desired job offer date)

- Search Committee completes final interviews and recommends 2-3 candidates to the Pastor / Parish Administrator for interview.
- Pastor or delegate offers position to the most qualified candidate, enters into salary negotiations, and sends offer letter.

JULY (or after attending Safe Conduct Protocol Workshop)

 New Director of Religious Education and / or Youth Ministry begins.
