#### Mass Explanations - Agnus Dei

If you attend the 10:30 am Mass or a daily Mass, you may notice that we've begun saying the *Agnus Dei* in Latin. This can be a bit of an adjustment, I know! If you don't have the words memorized, you can find them in the front of the hymnal in the section on the "Order of the Mass." Singing it in Latin is a beautiful moment of solidarity with so many other Catholics around the world that are singing the exact same words, and the ancient language of the Church is a sign of our unity not only with each other but with all of the Christians who have come before us. A few people have told me that they do miss saying it in English. If you fall into this category, one easy fix for that is to sing it in Latin with everyone else, and then quietly pray it in English while I prepare the altar to distribute communion. In my experience, though, there is something about praying in the language of the Church that, although it may be more difficult at first, becomes quite rewarding the more you do it.

#### Dear Parishioners,

- •St. Mary's Fine Arts Scholarship: For one student who is artistically talented and/or involved in theatre.

•Boy Scout Scholarship: For one student who is active in Boy Scouts.

These scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$3,000 and are renewable all four years under certain conditions. All families are welcome to apply for additional tuition assistance if needed.
