

ADOPT A SEMINARIAN PROGRAM

- Pray for your adopted seminarian every time you meet and/or at Mass.
- Post a picture of your adopted seminarian in the classrooms and hallways of your parish center.
- Please contact Greg Rader (grader@archindy.org) for a pdf of the seminarian posters.
- Once or twice a year, send a care package to your seminarian:
 - Have younger kids draw pictures
 - Have older kids write letters
 - Seminarians are busy and they are to devote their time to studies and formation. Thus, they generally cannot reply to each letter.... let kids know this.
 - Maybe include some snacks
- Distribute prayer cards with your adopted seminarian's picture on them to the kids. These will be provided by the Vocations Office. (Included in this mailing)
- Invite your adopted seminarian to visit over Christmas break or Holy Week:
 - It may be difficult for him to go to each classroom, though that invitation could be extended.
 - You could have him talk with all middle schoolers together and then all elementary school kids together.
 - He could serve at Mass and share his story after communion if your pastor wishes to extend that invitation.
