



In the Gospel of John, shortly before he is to suffer his Passion, Jesus proclaims to his disciples: "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As disciples of Christ, we are called to make a sacrificial gift of ourselves for the sake of our neighbor, for "to love someone is to desire that person's good and to take effective steps to secure it."

En el Evangelio según san Juan, poco antes de sufrir la Pasión, Jesús proclama a sus discípulos: "Les doy un mandamiento nuevo: ámense los unos a los otros. Liturgical Tidbits Cositas Litúrgicas

The Mass 101: Why do we have the Universal Prayer at Mass?



The Liturgy of the Word ends with the prayer of the faithful, also called the universal prayer. What we have was an adaption of the liturgy of the Jewish synagogue, which had prayers of intercession in the form of litanies (a series of petitions). It seems that this custom goes back to the apostolic times. St. Paul asks that prayers be offered for all men, especially for governors, since “God our Savior desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth” (1 Tim. 2:1-4). The first record of the universal prayer in our liturgy comes from Justin Martyr around the year 153 AD wherein describing the Mass said “common prayers that we fervently offer for ourselves, for our brothers, and for the rest of men wherever they may be” (I Apology 67, 4-5). It is called universal prayer because in it, we pray for the needs of the whole world, not just our own needs: for the Church, for civil authorities, for those oppressed by various needs, for all people, and for the salvation of the world.

¿Por qué tenemos la Oración Universal en la Misa?

La Liturgia de la Palabra finaliza con la oración de los fieles, también llamada oración universal. Lo que tenemos es una adaptación de la liturgia de la sinagoga judía, que tenía oraciones de intercesión en forma de letanías (una serie de peticiones). Parece que esta costumbre se remonta a los tiempos apostólicos. San Pablo pide que se ofrezcan oraciones por todos los hombres, especialmente por los gobernantes, ya que “Dios nuestro Salvador quiere que todos los hombres se salven y lleguen al conocimiento de la verdad” (1 Tim. 2:1-4). El primer registro de la oración universal en nuestra liturgia proviene de Justino Mártir alrededor del año 153 d.C. donde al describir la Misa decía “oraciones comunes que ofrecemos fervientemente por nosotros mismos, por nuestros hermanos y por el resto de los hombres dondequiera que estén” (I Apología 67, 4-5). Se llama oración universal porque en ella rezamos por las necesidades del mundo entero, no sólo por las nuestras: por la Iglesia, por las autoridades civiles, por los oprimidos por diversas necesidades, por todos los hombres y por la salvación del mundo. mundo.


