

HEALING OF ST. PETER'S MOTHER IN LAW SANACIÓN A LA SUEGRA DE SAN PEDRO



I remember hearing a few jokes about my mother-inlaw. Back in the "old days" it was a common theme and I've heard a joke about this miracle as well. But today I want to focus on a couple of things. One is that Jesus saw the need and responded to the healing. The other is the response of Peter's mother-in-law.

Jesus knows what we need and he knows what is going on in the world. We might think he is ignoring us but he isn't. Just because things don't work out the way we want doesn't mean that he isn't with us and he won't help us. All prayer is powerful and answered even if it might be in a way we don't expect or understand. The next thing is the response of Peter's mother-in-law after she was healed. Immediately "she served them". After her healing, she didn't pursue selfish actions but used her good health to serve Jesus and the people. It might be good for us to consider as well. Our health is an opportunity to serve God and his people. How can we trust in our God to respond like Peter's mother-in-law?

Nuestra salud es una oportunidad para servir a Dios y a su pueblo. ¿Cómo podemos confiar en que nuestro Dios responderá como la suegra de Pedro?



On this day we also give thanks to God for the gift of consecrated life to the Church. For centuries, those in consecrated life have given their lives to serve the poor, the uneducated, the sick, and the oppressed in education, medicine, science, and social justice.

What is Consecrated Life?

To consecrate means to set aside something or someone, or to devote something for a holy purpose. When men and women answer God's call to devote themselves, their lives are consecrated to God for the purpose of imitating Christ. They profess vows to God in order to live like Jesus in poverty, chastity, and obedience. They give themselves to Christ totally and wholeheartedly to bring the light of Christ to people through their missions in the Church.
