Pastor's Corner El rincón del Párroco

"IF YOU WISH YOU CAN HEAL ME." "SI LO DESEAS PUEDES CURARME."

For any of us who have had a serious illness, we desire healing. It is normal to have those desires. Who do we turn to when we want to be healed? Usually, if it is something ordinary we seek medical help and use the natural gifts God has given us through medicine and medical practice. Still, we shouldn't lose sight from the fact that ultimately God is the author of life and all healing goes back to him. I'd recommend that any time you are seeking healing through the natural medical means, it is good to ask Jesus to work through that process and acknowledge that he is the one who brings about healing. There are also times when healing is outside of the medical realm. Pray for healing. God can do "supernatural" healing as well. I have personally seen such things. The anointing of the sick, when it is a very serious illness, is a sacrament that brings about supernatural healing. Remember that healing is not always something physical. Sometimes we need spiritual healing, psychological healing, or emotional healing. Sometimes, we are in need of healing, that doesn't fit any category. Bring that also to God in your prayer and ask him to heal you. We say, "If you wish you can heal me," because we know that it ultimately comes from him. If He chooses to heal or not heal a particular situation, we know that he ultimately will heal us, and if we need to persevere in any illness in the meantime, let's do our best to leave it in his hands with patience and trusting faith. That can be difficult, but with God's help, it is possible.





Cualquiera de nosotros que haya tenido enfermedad grave deseamos curación. Es normal tener esos deseos. ¿A quién acudimos cuando queremos ser sanados? Por lo general, si es algo común buscamos ayuda médica y utilizamos los dones naturales que Dios nos ha dado a través de la medicina y la práctica médica. Aún así, no debemos perder de vista el hecho de que, en última instancia, Dios es el autor de la vida y toda curación regresa a él. Recomiendo que cada vez que busque curación a través de medios médicos naturales, sea bueno pedirle a Jesús que trabaje en ese proceso y reconozca que él es quien logra la curación. También hay ocasiones en las que la curación está fuera del ámbito médico. Ore por la curación. Dios también puede realizar curaciones "sobrenaturales". Yo personalmente he visto cosas así. La unción de los enfermos, cuando se trata de una enfermedad muy grave, es un sacramento que produce curación sobrenatural. Recuerda que la curación no siempre es algo físico. A veces necesitamos sanación espiritual, sanación psicológica o sanación emocional. A veces necesitamos sanación y eso no encaja en ninguna categoría. Lleva eso también a Dios en tu oración y pídele que te sane. Decimos: "Si lo deseas, puedes curarme", porque sabemos que, en última instancia, proviene de él. Si Él elige sanar o no una situación particular, sabemos que finalmente nos sanará, y si mientras tanto necesitamos perseverar en alguna enfermedad, hagamos todo lo posible para dejarla en sus manos con paciencia y fe confiada. Esto puede ser difícil, pero con la ayuda de Dios es posible.


