Pastor's Corner El rincón del Párroco

“JUST AS MOSES LIFTED UP THE SERPENT IN THE DESERT, SO MUST THE SON OF MAN BE LIFTED UP.”

After many of the Hebrews were bitten by snakes and dying, Moses was told to hold up a bronze serpent, and those who looked at it were healed. This was a prefiguration of Jesus who is lifted up on the cross. If we “look upon him” we are also healed. We should keep in mind that it isn’t mere “glancing” that heals but looking to Jesus as the source of our healing and allowing him to do it.

Some people don’t want to think about Jesus on the cross. It can seem a bit morbid or depressing to imagine. But that’s what happened. Jesus paid a very high price for his desire to save us. He held nothing back. This is not some sanitized version of salvation but real history and real life.

How have you been “bit” by the evils of this world? Do you have hurts, sickness, sin, destructive memories, or wounds? Are you angry, resentful, frustrated, or cynical? Have you felt like giving up or do you think much of this life is hopeless? If so, turn to Jesus on the cross and see him for who he truly is. It is not some morbid or masochistic image but is the fullest expression of God’s love for us and the greatest sign of what he has done to save us. Turn to him and let him do true healing in you.

“Así como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, así debe ser levantado el Hijo del Hombre”.

Después de que muchos de los hebreos fueron mordidos por serpientes y murieron, se le dijo a Moisés que sostuviera una serpiente de bronce y aquellos que la miraran eran sanados. Esta era una prefiguración de Jesús levantado en la cruz. Si “lo miramos” también somos sanados. Debemos tener en cuenta que no es la mera “mirada” lo que sana, sino mirar a Jesús como la fuente de nuestra curación y permitirle hacerlo.

Algunas personas no quieren pensar en Jesús en la cruz. Puede parecer un poco mórbido o deprimente imaginarlo. Pero eso es lo que pasó. Jesús pagó un precio muy alto por su deseo de salvarnos. No se guardó nada. Ésta no es una versión aséptica de la salvación, sino una historia real y una vida real.

¿Cómo has sido “mordido” por los males de este mundo? ¿Tienes heridas, enfermedades, pecados, recuerdos o heridas destructivas? ¿Estás enojado, resentido, frustrado o cínico? ¿Has sentido ganas de rendirte o crees que gran parte de esta vida no tiene esperanza? Si es así, recurra a Jesús en la cruz y véalo tal como es realmente. No es una imagen morbosa o masoquista sino que es la expresión más plena del amor de Dios por nosotros y la mayor señal de lo que ha hecho para salvarnos. Acude a él y deja que él haga en ti la verdadera curación.

What are scrutinies?

In the last column that I wrote, I spoke about the Rite of Election which is a formal acceptance of the Church of those adults who are to be baptized and received into full communion with the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil (March 30). This week we will speak about the Rite of Scrutinies. The "Scrutinies of the Elect" which take place during the three Sundays before Palm Sunday.

The Scrutinies are three special rites (celebrations) that help prepare the Elect, those participating in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), to enter the Catholic Church.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is “to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful” in the hearts of the Elect and to “strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.” (from Ritual Text for Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, paragraph #141)

To scrutinize means to examine something very closely. When we celebrate the Scrutinies at Mass, we are not scrutinizing the Elect. Rather, they are scrutinizing their own lives before God. The goal is to be strengthened to overcome the power of sin.

Those present at the Masses are not there just present to watch but are invited to also take a deep look into our own lives. The purifying of the Elect should become the purifying of us all.



What are scrutinies? ¿Qué son los escrutinios?



The Rite of Election & The Scrutinies

En la última columna que escribí, hablé sobre el Rito de Elección, que es una aceptación formal por parte de la Iglesia de aquellos adultos que serán bautizados y recibidos en plena comunión con la Iglesia Católica en la Vigilia Pascual (30 de marzo). Esta semana hablaremos sobre el Rito de los Escrutinios. Los "Escrutinios de los Elegidos" que se realizan durante los tres domingos anteriores al Domingo de Ramos.

Los Escrutinios son tres ritos (celebraciones) especiales que ayudan a preparar a los Elegidos, aquellos que participan en la Orden de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos (OCIA), para ingresar a la Iglesia Católica.

El propósito de los Escrutinios es “descubrir y luego sanar todo lo que es débil, defectuoso o pecaminoso” en los corazones de los Elegidos y “fortalecer todo lo recto, fuerte y bueno”. (del Texto ritual para el rito de iniciación cristiana para adultos, párrafo #141)

Escudriñar significa examinar algo muy de cerca. Cuando celebramos los Escrutinios en la Misa, no estamos escudriñando a los Elegidos. Más bien, están examinando sus propias vidas ante Dios. El objetivo es ser fortalecidos para vencer el poder del pecado.

Los presentes en las Misas no están allí sólo para mirar, sino que también están invitados a echar una mirada profunda a nuestras propias vidas. La purificación de los Elegidos debe convertirse en la purificación de todos nosotros.


