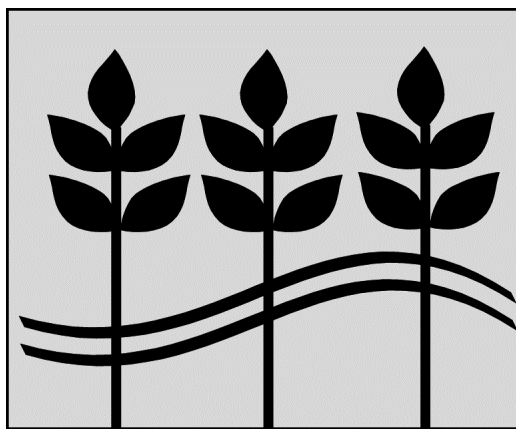

“For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.”

Whether we hear the Scriptures Readings for Year B (quoted above) or the Year A Readings for The Second Scrutiny, we hear this same message. God, who has in various ways in the past shown favor, mercy to his people, has now through His Son, offered us healing and the opportunity to see God face to face.

In the long form of the Gospel for The Scrutinies, Jesus heals a blind man. Yet, much of the passage is sidetracked by a discussion of how this person came to be born blind, who sinned, what is the root cause and how is it that he can now see.

During these last few weeks of Lent, let us not be so consumed by condemnation, short-sighted by blame and guilt. Rather, let us present ourselves before the captors and critics confident that our role is not to win their appeasement, but to submit to the power of God, who heals, consoles, strengthens, and welcomes us back to the fullness of life with Him. Let us see our Savior more clearly as the daylight grows stronger and Easter draws nearer.

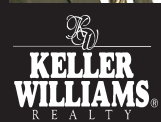
