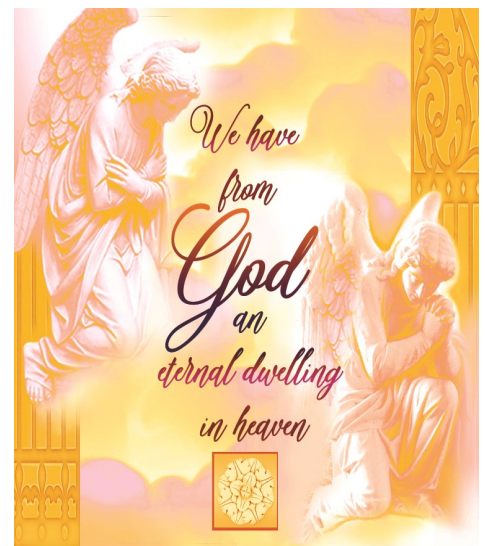

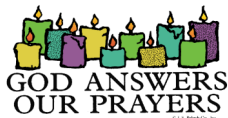

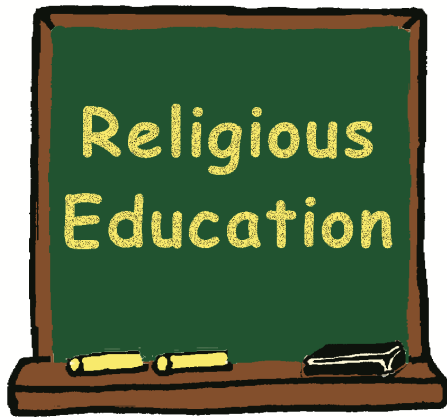

As we return to “Ordinary Time” we find ourselves back at the beginning hearing the story of Genesis and The Garden of Eden where Adam & Eve succumb to temptation and “The Fall.” Compare this to the Gospel in which Jesus, at the beginning of his ministry is beset with confused followers and critics so that he must speak to them in parables—spiritual riddles with surprising lessons.

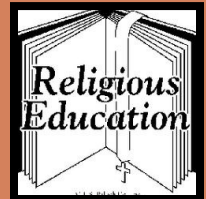

On June 1, 2018, the Diocese of Arlington and the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement announced that effective September 1, 2018, priests of the Diocese of Arlington will assume the pastoral care and administration of Christ the Redeemer Church in Sterling, Virginia. Christ the Redeemer parish has been staffed by the Atonement Friars since its founding in 1972.

Arlington Bishop Michael F. Burbidge thanked the Atonement Friars for 46 years of generous and fruitful ministry to the parishioners of Christ the Redeemer. "I am most grateful for the Atonement Friars sharing their charism for promoting unity within our Church during the years in which we all witnessed tremendous growth in the Catholic population in Sterling. In particular, I am grateful to the Friars for welcoming and encouraging the spiritual growth of so many Spanish-speaking Catholics who make up our Diocesan family."

Minster General V. Rev. Brian Terry, SA stated, "The Friars have been serving in Sterling since 1971, when we met in Sterling Elementary School cafeteria for Sunday Liturgies. I remember arriving early to Mass as a young boy to help fold up the cafeteria tables and set out the very cold metal folding chairs. Christ the Redeemer parish has had very simple and humble beginnings and blossomed into a vibrant faith community.

The Friars have accompanied the community through years of growth with great joy and have found it a privilege to serve the People of God in Northern Virginia. It is our greatest prayer that the new Pastor and Parochial Vicar will be welcomed with open hearts as we were welcomed so many years ago. In the words of St. Francis,

*The Lord bless you and keep you. May He show His face to you and have mercy. May He turn His countenance to you and give you peace. The Lord bless you.*

Atonement Friars Father Francis Eldridge, SA; Father Thomas Gumprecht, SA; and Father Robert Langone, SA will be assigned to other ministries within their community. Bishop Burbidge has named Father J.D. Jaffe, currently Director of the Office of Vocations in the Diocese of Arlington, to be the Pastor of Christ the Redeemer Church, and Father Mark Moretti, currently Parochial Vicar at Precious Blood Church in Culpeper, to be Parochial Vicar at Christ the Redeemer effective September 1, 2018.
